

(v) Occupation/reservation etc. of teachers qtrs. by Non-Teachers.

The teachers quarters occupied by the Non-teachers and also the quarters used/reserved/occupied by the University for other purpose should vacate by 25.5.97 and these quarters should be made available for allotment to teachers. Annexure I (Extract from NEHUT G.B.M.).

The teachers quarters used/reserved/occupied by the University for other purpose identified by office :

1. The L/Type quarter No.41 was allotted to the Resident Doctor, Dr.(Mrs.) M. Marwein on the recommendation of the Residence Allotment Committee in its meeting held on 17.8.91 which resolved that the said quarter be temporarily allotted to the Medical Officer till the quarter for the M.O. is completed. Annexure - II
2. The L/Type quarter No.55 was allotted to Dr. S.N. Rai during the time he was holding the post of Readership. Dr.S.N. Rai was then appointed as the Director, Computer Centre w.e.f. 19.8.93 and is still occupying the quarter till date. As Dr. S.N. Rai is now holding the administrative post he is no longer entitled to the teacher quarters according to the House Allotment Rules. He has therefore been requested to vacate the quarter vide letter at Annexure III.
3. The L-Type No.48 is still retaining/Occupying by Prof. T.S.B. Narasaraju re-employed as the Prof.-in-charge, USIC. The guidelines approved by E.C. in its 90th Meeting for re-employment of NEHU teachers is placed at Annexure - IV where it says that physical facilities and other department/universities amenities enjoyed by the teacher prior to his lien/retirement will continue to be available to him.
4. The P/type No.4 is earmarked for the Rajiv Gandhi Chair as per Ordinance OB:15(ii) Annexure - V. The Residence Allotment Committee in its meeting held on 23.7.96 resolved that the said quarter be reserved for the purpose it is allotted for a further period of six months. In case the chair is not filled up within this period, allotment of the said quarter will be reviewed by the committee. Annexure - VI Extracts of the NEHUTA GBM resolutions Annexure - VII 2(v) was placed in the Residence Allotment Committee meeting held on 27.6.97. ANNEXURE - IV

GUIDELINES FOR RE-EMPLOYMENT OF TEACHERS

The modified Rules for re-employment of teachers of NEHU may be as under:

NEHU extends the benefit of re-employment to its superannuated teachers on the following conditions :-

The teacher on retirement may be re-employed for a period of two years from the date of retirement against the post vacated by him/her subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions :

Such teacher shall not hold any administrative position.

ELIGIBILITY :

1. A superannuated teacher will be eligible for re-employment provided he has served NEHU, its constituent college and Institutions for a minimum period of 10 years.
2. He/She should be academically active with good record of service.
3. He/She should be physically fit and certified as such by NEHU C.M.O.
4. Teachers of all categories of the University as well as constituent colleges fulfilling the above conditions will be eligible for consideration.

PROCEDURE :

1. Application for re-employment should be made by the teacher concerned to the Vice-Chancellor approximately one year prior to the date of retirement.
2. The Vice-Chancellor will place the application for the consideration and approval of the EC and its decision shall be final.
3. The University shall intimate its decision to the concerned teacher within one month before retirement.

REMUNERATION & OTHER FACILITIES :

1. A re-employed teacher will be entitled to pay as per rules governing fixation of pay of re-employed persons.
2. Physical facilities and other departmental/University's amenities enjoyed by the teacher prior to his/her retirement will continue to be available to him/her.

Extract of draft resolutions adopted by the NEHUTA GBM held
on 23.5.97

2. The GBM discussed the matters related to house allotment and resolved the following :

- i) The ~~GBM~~ teachers should be made to shift to their allotted entitlement houses by the date given by the GBM held on 9.5.97(i.e.26.5.97).
- ii) The GBM expressed serious concern over adhoc and unilateral decisions of NEHU EC violating the House Allotment Rules leading to un-necessary complications. The Chairman, NEHU EC may be requested not to consider individual complaints regarding House Allotment. The complaints should be first referred to the Residence Allotment Committee for its option.
- iii) The GBM resolved that if the teachers fail ~~to~~ in shifting to their allotted entitlement houses within the stipulated time, their allotments should be cancelled as per Clause 5(iv) of the House Allotment Rules. Since Clause 5(ii) of House Allotment Rules does not allow allotment of lower type house than ones entitlement, the teachers should be asked to vacate the houses of the lower type.
- iv) Qtr.No.P/1 should be allotted on temporary basis as per station seniority list.
- v) NEHU Admn. should look ~~into~~ into its records to find out the houses occupied by persons not entitled for the houses meant for teachers. Alternative accommodation should be provided to the Resident Doctor and the Faculty Club in the Permanent Campus.
- vi) The University should take urgent steps to complete four P/Type houses dunder construction/litigation.
