

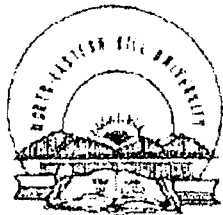

5:1- Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations & Rules

(i) Framing an ordinance on Guidelines for Award of Honorary Degree

AC:69:2003:5:1:(i):The Council considered the minutes of the Committee to suggest guidelines for an ordinance on the award of Honorary Degrees and **RESOLVED** to approve the Committee's suggestions with the following modifications. The item (ii) (a) may be read as follows:

'Distinguished persons/Public Institutions and Different Academic Bodies of NEHU'.

However, another committee may be constituted to prepare a draft Ordinance in the light of the provision in the Statutes.

(ii) UGC Guidelines on Break-up of workload of teachers – proposal for amendment of the University Ordinance OB-5 in line with UGC Guidelines.

AC:69:2003:5:1:(ii) The Council considered the University Ordinance OB-5 regarding workload of teachers and **RESOLVED** that a Committee be constituted to suggest amendments to the Ordinance in the light of the new UGC guidelines. In suggesting amendments the Committee should (i) provide a suitable definition of "actual teaching" time; (ii) take into consideration the special kind of work done in the Centres and (iii) indicate, if necessary, separate provisions for professional courses.

(iii) Framing of Ordinances for Professional Courses-Committees recommendation thereof

AC:69:2003:5:1:(iii): The Council considered the Draft Ordinance for professional courses, as submitted by the Committee constituted for the purpose and **RESOLVED** to approve the same. However, it was further resolved that in addition to this general Ordinance for professional courses separate regulations may be prepared for each professional course as and when required.

iv) Second Conference of the Vice –Chancellors of Central Universities held on May 25-26,2003 at IGNOU Campus, New Delhi

AC:69:2003:5:1:(iv): The Council considered the action taken report on the recommendations of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Conference of the Vice Chancellors of the Central Universities and **RESOLVED** as follows:

1) A Committee may be constituted to prepare the document “ Vision 2025” for NEHU.

2) Since review of Act and Statutes is an ongoing process the University may send a report accordingly.

3) Regarding decentralization of decision making, it was suggested that, in addition to the Standing Committees which already exist, other suitable empowered Standing Committees may be constituted for different aspects of University administration. A Committee may be constituted to suggest and specify the number of such Standing Committees.

4) The Council also noted all other informations furnished by DR(Acad), NEHU to the Ministry of Human Resources Development.

v) Ordinance on Career Advancement Scheme for the University teachers

AC:69:2003:5:1:(v): The Council considered the amended Ordinance OE-16 in the light of UGC Guidelines and **RESOLVED** that, the portion of the amended Ordinance which is not in consonance with the UGC Guidelines may be deleted and the amended draft be sent back to the Ministry of Human Resources Development for the Visitor’s assent.

- vi) Guidelines for counting of past service for promotion from Reader to Professor under Career Advancement Scheme

AC:69:2003:5:1:(vi) The Council considered the UGC Guidelines for counting of past service for promotion from Reader to Professor and **RESOLVED** to approve the same.

- vii) Regulation on the Certificate Course in Floriculture

AC:69:2003:5:1:(vii): The Council considered the regulation on the Certificate course in Floriculture and **RESOLVED** to approve the same. However it was further **RESOLVED** that one course may be designed for Bachelor's degree holders and another for the non-graduates and study materials for the latter may be made available in English as well as in Khasi and Garo. It was also **RESOLVED** that, except the new items, all other items of fee may be integrated into existing NEHU fee structure.

- viii) Student strength in M.A. Sociology

AC:69:2003:5:1:(viii):The Council considered the proposal to increase the intake capacity of students for M.A. in Sociology from 40 to 45 from the Academic session, August 2003 onwards and **RESOLVED** to approve the same.

## 5:2- SYLLABUS

- (i) Revised syllabus for BA/B.SC- General and Honours in Statistics

AC:69:2003:5:2:(i): The Council considered the Revised Syllabus BA/B.SC- General and Honours in Statistics and **RESOLVED** to approve the same.

## (ii) Revised syllabus for B.Sc in computer Science

AC:69:2003:5:2:(ii): The Council considered the Syllabus for B.Sc (Computer Science) and **RESOLVED** that Chairman, BUGS (Computer Science) will revise the same in the light of the written comments to be received from the members.

## (iii) Revised syllabus for M.A in Philosophy

AC:69:2003:5:2:(iii): The Council considered the Syllabus for M.A in Philosophy and **RESOLVED** to approve the same. The Chairman, BPGS in Philosophy, agreed to incorporate, in the final version to be submitted to the University, suggestions made by some members.

## (iv) Revised M.A.(Education) syllabus

AC:69:2003:5:2:(iv): The Council considered the Syllabus for M.A in Education and **RESOLVED** that revisions, as suggested by several member of the Council should be carried out. The Department may seek the help of faculty from the School of Social Sciences in doing so.

## (v) Revised syllabus for M.A/M.Sc Economics, 2002

AC:69:2003:5:2:(v): The Council considered inclusion of a Special paper on North East in the revised Syllabus for M.A/M.Sc Economics and **RESOLVED** to accept the same after minor revisions in consultation with Prof. M.N. Karna.

(vi) Syllabus for two Diploma Courses in  
Visual Arts (Painting) and  
Performing Arts (Music).

AC:69:2003:5:2:(vi): The Council considered the Syllabus for Diploma Courses in Visual Arts (Painting), Performing Arts (Music) and **RESOLVED** to approve the same. It was, however, **RESOLVED** that the courses be titled respectively as (i) Painting and (ii) Music.

## (vii) Revised Syllabus of M.Sc (Physics)

AC:69:2003:5:2:(vii): The Council considered the revised Syllabus for M.Sc (Physics) and **RESOLVED** to approve the same.

## (viii) Revised Syllabus of Curriculum of Mass Communication and Video Production

AC:69:2003:5:2:(viii): The Council considered Syllabus of Curriculum of Mass Communication and Video Production and **RESOLVED** to approve the same with revisions to be incorporated in the light of written comments to be received from members.

## (ix) Revised Syllabus in Anthropology

AC:69:2003:5:2:(ix):The Council considered the revised Syllabus in Anthropology and **RESOLVED** to approve the same with revision to be incorporated by Chairman, BUGS, in the light of comments of members.

## (x) Revised Syllabus for B.Sc (Physics) Pass and Honours

AC:69:2003:5:2:(x):The Council considered the Syllabus for B.Sc (Physics) Pass and Honours and **RESOLVED** that a committee of two members consisting of Prof. M.K. Parida & Prof. C.S. Sashtri may be constituted to finalize the same as per the written comments to be received from members.

## (xi) Draft Syllabus for B.E. in Electronics and Communication Engineering (four years Degree course).

AC:69:2003:5:2:(xi): The Council considered the Syllabus for B.E. in Electronics and Communication Engineering (four years Degree course) and **RESOLVED** to approve the same.

- (xii) Draft Syllabus for B.E. in Computer Science and Engineering.

AC:69:2003:5:2:(xii): The Council considered the Syllabus for Computer Science and Engineering and **RESOLVED** to approve the same.

### 5:3 – RESEARCH

- (i) Joint Research Study on the Tribal people inhabiting the India – Myanmar Border area.

AC:69:2003:5:3:(i): The Council considered the proposal for Joint Research Study (between NEHU and the University of Yangon) on the Tribal people inhabiting the India – Myanmar Border area and noted the same.

### 5:5 – EXAMINATION MATTERS

- (i) To recognize academic calendar of the University

AC:69:2003:5:5:(i): The Council considered the report of the Committee constituted to reorganize the Academic calendar of the University and **RESOLVED** to approve the same. However, It was further **RESOLVED** that the Colleges should initiate steps to reduce the number of subject combinations made available to students so as to enable the Examination Department to complete the Under Graduate Examinations within a short span of time.

### 5:6 – ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW DEPTTS/CENTRES/COURSE

- (i) Starting a three year professional Diploma/Degree Course in Visual Art/Performing Arts etc. in the Creative Arts Unit

AC:69:2003.5:6:(i)

This item was withdrawn.

(ii) National Assessment and Accreditation Council (IQAC)

AC:69:2003:5:6 : (ii) The Council considered the establishment of an Internal Quality Assurance Cell and **RESOLVED** to approve the same. However the Cell should be provided with all necessary infrastructural facilities. The Cell will also develop as an information resource centre for the University.

(iii) Assessment of Science Departments

AC:69:2003:5:6:(iii): The Council **RESOLVED** that NAAC may be requested to take up the work of accreditation of the Departments in the School of Life Sciences.

(iv) Proposal of taking over the Tura Law College

AC:69:2003:5:6:(iv): The Council considered the report of the Committee constituted for taking over of Tura Law College and **RESOLVED** to approve the same.

(v) Vision Plan for Jowai campus vis-a-vis Shillong and Tura Campuses

AC:69:2003:5:6:(v): The Council considered the report of the committee constituted for preparing a vision plan for Jowai campus and **RESOLVED** to approve the same. However it was further **RESOLVED** that the matter may be placed to the Planning Committee for the preparation of a consolidated plan document to be forwarded to UGC.

### 5:7 – AFFILIATION CASES ETC

#### (i) Affiliation Cases of various Colleges

AC:69:2003:5:7:(i): The Council considered the recommendations of the Inspection teams on affiliation cases of various colleges and **RESOLVED** to approve the same (as per the APPENDIX – II) with the following comments :

- (1) The Council agreed that the Report of the Inspection Team may be sent to St. Dominick College for their response.
- (2) It was further **RESOLVED** that affiliation for NERIST, Itanagar, Arunachal Pradesh was for three years instead of one year and that this decision should be communicated to the NERIST by the Director, CDC, NEHU.

### 5:8 – OTHERS

#### (i) Rationalization of Fee Structure in the University/College system

AC:69:2003:5:8:(i): The Council considered the recommendations of various committees, NEIPA, 9<sup>th</sup> Report of the Expenditure Reforms Commission, Frame work for restructuring of University and College fees by the MHRD and **RESOLVED** to set up a committee which will include the Student representatives on the A.C. However it was further **RESOLVED** that a standing committee should be constituted to suggest revisions of the fee structure every two years.

#### (ii) Concessions for Admissions 2003-04 for wards of Kashmiri Migrants.

AC:69:2003:5:8:(ii): The Council considered the matter concessions for the wards of the Kashmiri Migrants in admissions to the educational institutions during the Academic Sessions 2003-04 and **RESOLVED** to approve the same.

## (iii) Nomination of the members to the Board of under Graduate Studies

AC:69:2003:5:8:(iii): The Council considered nomination of three members to the BUGS in Geology, Statistics and Sanskrit and **RESOLVED** to authorize the Chairman, to nominate the members. However it was further **RESOLVED** that the Head, Centre for Applied Statistics be nominated as the Chairman, BUGS in Statistics.

## (iv) Appointment of Rajiv Gandhi Chair

AC:69:2003:5:8:(iv): The Council considered the appointment of Rajiv Gandhi Chair and **RESOLVED** that a committee be constituted to suggest names for consideration of appointment to the Chair.

## (v) Restructuring of the Centres of Studies

AC:69:2003:5:8:(v):The Council considered the report submitted by the Committee for restructuring of the Centre of Studies and **RESOLVED** to accept its recommendation to the effect that “Units” of Centres be abolished. It was, further, **RESOLVED** that the same Committee may suggest further restructuring of the Centres keeping in view the relative largeness of some of the existing Centres.

**AC:69:2003:6:2:(i):** The Council considered Re-employment of Teachers in NEHU and **RESOLVED** as follows:

1. The age of superannuation of University teachers shall be 62 years and thereafter no extension in service should be given.
2. The scheme of 're-employment' currently in force should be discontinued forth with.
3. All those whose services were extended under the current scheme of re-employment should be given three months' notice of termination.
4. A Committee may be constituted to frame a draft ordinance for re-employment in terms of existing UGC guidelines.

### 6:3 - LEAVE/DEPUTATION ETC

- (i) Grant of Leave for attending Seminars/Workshop etc.

AC:69:2003:6:3:(i): The Council considered the amendment to Clause 3 and 4 of OE-6 and **RESOLVED** to approve the same with the modification that for short periods of absence, Special Casual Leave may be granted and for longer durations, Duty Leave may be granted.

- (ii) Study leave provisions in OE-6

AC:69:2003:6:3:(ii): The Council considered the proposed amendment to OE-6 regarding Study Leave and **RESOLVED** to approve the same.

### 6:7 - OTHERS


- (i) Recommendations on Academic & Financial Management of NEHU


**Item No. 8                    ITEMS FROM THE CHAIR**
