Counting of past services rendered under the Govt. of Nagaland in respect of Dr.R.K. Tiwari, Dy. Registrar.

Dr. R.K. Tiwari, Deputy Registrar has been confirmed and permanently absorbed in the University with effect from 9.10.92 and the University has also decided to count his past services rendered under the Government of Nagaland in different capacities with effect from 1.9.72 to 8.10.92 for pension, gratuity, family pension and other benefits as admissible to NEHU employees, provided the Government of Nagaland discharge his pension liability by paying in lumpsum as one time payment for the service rendered under the Government of Nagaland for the aforesaid period.

In pursuance of the letter from the Registrar, NEHU, vide No.F.14-158/Estt.II/92-3735 dated 1.12.95 to the Secretary to the Government of Nagaland, Higher & Technical Education and as per the letter No.BBS(0) 62/81 dated 20.12.95 from the Under Secretary to the Government of Nagaland to the Accountant General, Kohima, the Accountant General has cleared all the pension liabilities of Dr. R.K. Tiwari vide their letter No.FEN/927 of 95-96, and an amount of Rs.2,25,762.00 has been remitted to NEHU, Shillong vide Bank Draft No.480422 dated 5.2.96. Further, his GPF balance with interest thereon amounting to Rs.27,464/- has also been sent to NEHU vide Bank Draft No.304162 dated 21.5.96.

In view of the above, the matter is now placed before the Executive Council for counting the past services of Dr. R. K. Tiwari rendered under the Government of Nagaland for the period with effect from 1.9.72 to 8.10.92.
