- (i) Amendment of rules for re-employment of Teachers.

The Executive Council in its 94th meeting held on 23rd September, 1997, vide resolution No.EC:94:97:7:6:(i): resolved that clause 1 of RU-2 may read as under :

" The teacher on retirement may be re-employed for a period of two years from the date of retirement against the post vacated/teaching position last held by him/her subject to fulfilment of the following conditions":-

- (ii) Clause 3 under 'Eligibility' may read as under :

" He/She should be physically fit and certified as such by NEHU Senior Medical Officer-InCharge".

The matter was placed before the Academic Council in its 56th meeting held on 21st and 22nd November, 1997 which resolved to accept the decision of the Executive Council.
