Shri. Amal Kumar Mondal, Professional Asstt. NEHU Tura Campus in his letter dated 14.5.2007 along with the recommendation of his Controlling Officer (see Annexure III & IV) has requested the University Authority to grant him 1(one) year Study Leave w.e.f. 1st September, 2007 to as to enable him to complete his Ph.D works under the Supervision of Dr.R,K.Barman, on the topic "CITATION PATTERN OF PHYSICISTS: a Bibliometric Study of Ph.D thesis submitted to Gauhati University,Guwahati, 1970-2000" in the Department of Library and Information Science, Guwahati University, Guwahati.

In this regard, it may be pointed out that as per CCS Leave Rule 51, Study leave may be granted to the Govt. Servant :-

- (a) Ordinarily 12 months at any one time, and
- (b) During his entire service, twenty-four months in all (inclusive of similar kind of leave for study or training granted under any other rules.)

Shri. Amal Kumar Mandal has completed 14 years of continuous service in NEHU. Earlier as requested by him vide his letter dated 27.1.2005(see Annexure I) to issue the NOC to him, the University Authority has accordingly issued the same vide this Office of even No. 3090 dated 23rd February 2005,(see Annexure-II) allowing him to pursue his Ph.D Programme and it was clearly stipulated in the NOC that the said pursuit shall not in any way ,hamper or hinder his normal duties in the University, as also committed by him in his letter.



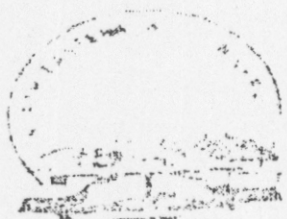
