(i) RESERVATION FOR GENERAL SC/ST CANDIDATES FOR ADMISSION TO PG HOSTELS.

It ^{may} be noted that present policy of admission to the PG Hostel is governed by the following:-

- I) 60% for Sc/ST candidates belonging to the States under the jurisdiction of NEHU (Meghalaya and Mizoram)
- II) 30% open for general candidates.
- III) 10% reserved for Vice-Chancellor's Quota for the following categories of students.
 - a) Students nominated by the Central Government.
 - b) Unrepresented Backward Areas
 - c) Physically handicapped
 - d) Outstanding Sportsmen/Sports-women
 - e) Children of NEHU employees
 - f) Employees with All India Transfer Liability excluding private organisations.
 - g) Donor Non-Resident Indians

Meanwhile the University has received a number of representations from Sc/ST candidates hailing from other States requesting for reservation of a certain limit of quota for admission to the PG Hostels. In addition, Government of India from time to time have been asking for reservation for such categories of candidates.

In the light of the above, The EC may consider the following proposals of reservations for admission to the PG hostels which have been prepared in consultation with the DSW.

- I) 25% Open
- II) 50% for SC/ST candidates from the States under the jurisdiction of NEHU.
- III) 20% for other SC/ST candidates including the SC/ST candidates from the states under the jurisdiction of NEHU.
- IV) 5% Vice-Chancellor's Quota for the categories of candidates referred to above III (a to g)

The E.C may consider the above proposal for decision.

- (i) Distribution of Seats for General and SC/ST Candidates for Admission to P.G. Hostels.

No: EC: 90: 96: 5: 8: (i): The Council considered the distribution of seats in the P.G. Hostels and RESOLVED that the seats may be distributed as follows:

I. 30% Open

II. 50% for SC/ST candidates from States under the jurisdiction of NEHU.

III. 15% for SC/ST candidates hailing from States other than those under the jurisdiction of NEHU in case they can not be accommodated under II above.

IV. 5% Vice-Chancellor's Quota for the following categories of candidates:

- (a) Students nominated by the Central Government.
- (b) Unrepresented Backward Areas.
- (c) Physically handicapped.
- (d) Outstanding Sportsmen/Sports-women
- (e) Children of NEHU employees
- (f) Employees with All India Transfer Liability excluding private organisations.
- (g) Donor Non-Resident Indians.

- (ii) Identification of the allied and cognate Departments for the constitution of the Board of Post-Graduate Studies, Department of Geology.
