Subject : 1) Retirement on Invalidation - Extension of Invalid Pension to Shri Barton Kharmalki, Gate-Keeper, Library Deptt.

Shri Barton Kharmalki, Gate-Keeper of the Library Deptt. NEHU, Shillong joined the University on 31.5.86 and has completed more than 10 years of service.

The said official requested for invalid pension by retiring him on medical ground and the case was referred to the University Medical Board (Annexure.I) for proper medical examination in order to confirm whether the said official is permanently incapacitated for further service in the University.

The Medical Board having examined Shri Barton Kharmalki on the 30.11.96 duly recommended the case for Invalid Pension. In this regard the observations of the Medical Board may be perused at Annexure-II.

In terms of Rule 38 of CCS (Pension Rules) at Annexure III. invalid pension may be granted if a Govt. servant retire from the service on account of any bodily or mental infirmity which permanently incapacitated him for the service.

In the light of the said report of the Medical Board, the proposal to retire Shri Barton Kharmalki, Gate-Keeper from the University Service may be considered with effect from 30.11.96 and the said official may be admitted to Invalid Pension.

1. Mr.B. Kharmalki :Mr.B.Kharmalki has been examined by the Medical Board which included a Psychiatrist,Dr.S.Syiem and the Board recommends that he may be considered for invalid pension.
2. Mr. R.Sharma : Mr.R.Sharma has been examined by the Medical Board and the ENT Surgeon,Dr(Mrs) J.G.Jyrwa who is on the medical Board,after clinical examination asked for an Audiogram of the candidate. The audiogram done at the School and Centre for the Hearing Handicapped Children,Shillong on the 16.4.97 revealed Bilateral Profound Sensori-neuronal hearing loss (more than 90 decibels) and the ENT Surgeon of the Medical Board had certified,that the candidate had 'Bilateral Profound & Sensory Neuronal hearing loss'.

The Medical Board,therefore recommends that Mr.R.Sharma may be considered as a Physically Handicapped( hearing-impaired) person.
