The Academic Council Committee constituted vide notification No.AC:61-4/Conf/99-1314:dt.23.7.99 to examine the provision of Ordinance OC-5 on the eligibility criteria for teaching M.Phil Courses & Supervision of research work met on 30th August, 1999 after detail deliberation on various aspects recommend certain points for consideration & appropriate decision of the Academic Council. The Report of the Committee is placed as Annexure 'A'.

The matter was placed before the 62nd meeting of the Academic Council and the Council Resolved to approve the same.

Registration and Supervision:

Clause 5 (1): A candidate, during the course work, shall apply through the department Board of Post Graduate Studies for registration along with the synopsis which should be approved by the School Board and shall be the effective date of registration.

Clause 5 (2): The department shall appoint a supervisor. The supervisor shall be a Professor, Reader or a Lecturer with Ph D and with at least three years experience of research teaching and should be a teacher of this University.

1 (c). Under clause 3 on "Course Work" in the Ordinance OC-5, the sub-clause 3(1) may be modified as:

The course work shall consist of three courses offered by the department. A teacher of this University having at least an M Phil Degree shall be eligible to teach M. Phil Courses.
