i) Advertisement of vacancies in academic cadres

As per Clauses 2(1) of Ordinance OE-4 on notification of vacancies and preliminary selections, all vacancies in Academic Cadres of the University shall be advertised in at least four India papers, one each from the eastern, northern, Western and southern region and at least one regional paper each of the constituent units of the University.

Provided that if there are some academic positions which the candidates are likely to be exclusively available in a particular region or regions, advertisement may be limited to the papers in that region or regions, only after recording the reasons for doing so in writing and with prior approval of the Vice-Chancellor.

The Executive Council in its 84th meeting held on 8.12.94 vide resolution No:EC:84:94:6:7(iii) resolved that as a measure of economy, advertisements for vacancies in Academic cadres be floated only in the Employment News and in one of the local newspapers of the States under the jurisdiction of NEHU.

In view of the above decisions the proposal for amendment of the relevant Ordinance quoted above was referred to the Ministry for approval of the Ministry.

The Ministry, however, replied that the operation of the said Ordinance may be suspended pending decision in the matter by the Visitor. The matter was also placed before the 94th Executive Council meeting and the Council vide resolution No:EC:94:97:3:(ii) noted the action taken in the amendment of Clause 2 (1) of Ordinance OE-4 and resolved that further action on the same may be taken on receipt of further intimation from Ministry of Human Resource Development. In the same meeting vide resolution No:EC:94:97:5:1(1) the Council considered the proposal to advertise the various vacant posts of the University in the University News published by the AIU and resolved that the same be referred to the Academic Council.

The matter was therefore placed before the Academic Council in its 56th meeting held on 21st and 22nd Nov, 1997, which considered the advertisement of teaching posts and resolved that the posts may be advertised in four national newspapers as well as in the regional newspapers as laid down in the Ordinances and the advertisement may also be sent to the university News as well.

In the meantime another letter has been received from the Ministry (Annexer-'A') in which they have directed suspension of the operation of the proposed amendment of Clause 2(1) of Ordinance OE-4 and the views of the Visitor be placed before the Executive Council for its information as stipulated under Section 41(6) of the NEHU Act, 1973.

The matter is therefore placed before the Council for consideration.
