- (iii) Consideration of lien in respect of faculty members of the University for holding Administrative Tenure Posts.

Dr. D.R. Syiemlieh, Professor of History, NEHU, has been appointed as Controller of Examinations NEHU for a period of 5 (five) years with effect from 31.3.2008 (A/N). On assuming the duties of COE Dr. Syiemlieh, vide his letter dated 31st March, 2008 (**vide Annexure-A**), has requested the University to grant him lien initially for a period for 2 (two) years and also to permit him to continue supervision of Ph.D. Scholars, several of whom are in the final stage of their research. Dr. Syiemlieh has been permitted by the Vice-Chancellor, subject to the ratification of the Executive Council, to supervise the Ph.D. Scholars. A written permission communicated to Dr. Syiemlieh may kindly be seen (**vide Annexure-B**). In regard to grant of lien to Dr. Syiemlieh, it may be reiterated that Dr. Syiemlieh has been appointed against the post of controller of examinations, which is a tenure post for a period of 5 (five) years. As such, Dr. Syiemlieh would continue to retain his lien against the substantive post of Professor of History, NEHU, till the expiry of his terms of appointment. There are also similar cases where some of the faculty members of the University, as detailed below, have been appointed against the administrative positions having 5 (five) years tenure.
