

6:3: Leave/Deputation

(1) Duty leave for 3 months applied by Prof. S.Miri.

Prof. S. Miri, Philosophy Deptt. has applied E.O.L. for a period of one year w.e.f. June 1998 to take up a fellowship awarded by the Indian Institute of Advanced Study, Shimla Vide Annexure "A".

However, since Prof. Miri was on E.O.L. for a period w.e.f. 12.94 to 30.11.97, her request for E.O.L. has been regretted by the E.C. in its meeting held on the 14.7.98 Annexure "B" under Ordinance No. 6 Cl.8 since she has to complete five years continuous service from the previous spell of E.O.L.

Now, Prof. Miri vide application Annexure "C" she has requested to grant duty leave for a period of 3 months since the E.C. has regretted her E.O.L. to enable her to complete the project.

However, as per Ordinance referred and as decided in the last E.C. it appears that the teacher has to complete five years continuous service from the previous spell of leave.

For information of the Council it may be stated that the request of Dr. Vinod Singh for grant of duty leave for a period of 90 days with effect from 1.4.98 to 29.6.98 has been placed in the 96th E.C. held on the 24.3.98 since the teacher has availed study leave w.e.f. 20.2.95 to 19.2.97 and as per Ordinance the teacher has to serve the University for a continuous period equal to the period of study leave actually availed, although the Duty leave Rules is silent; where-as the leave applied is still within the continuing period for which the teacher has to serve. Thus, as per Annexure -'D' the E.C. in its meeting held on the 24.3.98 has regretted the duty leave applied.

Hence, in view of the position explained the matter is placed before the Executive Council for decision.

Madam,

This relates to the award of Fellowship in this Institute.

2. We have great pleasure in informing you that the chairman, Governing Body of the Institute has approved the award of a Fellowship to you for a period of one year to enable you to pursue the research project on "Autonomy of the Tribal Form of Life". The period of Fellowship could be extended for upto one year more, if deemed necessary subject, however, to prior approval of the Governing Body.

3. During the term of your fellowship at the Institute, you will be given a Fellowship Grant equivalent to your basic pay being drawn by you at present plus allowances as are admissible to Central Government employees stationed at Shimla and free hardfurnished accommodation for your stay in Shimla. The hard furnished accommodation will include 4 chairs, 3 tables, one dining table with 4 chairs, one crockery Almirah, 2 beds, one dressing table, 2 book racks and one Wardrobe only. You are advised to bring your lines articles etc.

4. You are requested to bring with you (or send by mail) your last pay certificate from your parent organisation indicating clearly the date of relief, pay scale, break-up of emoluments drawn, regular deductions on account of provident fund etc. date of next increment and also a certificate that you have been granted extra- ordinary leave (without pay) by your institution to take up the Fellowship. Please note that a Fellow of the Institute must draw his Fellowship Grant from the Institute and cannot be in the payroll of any other organization during the tenure of his/her Fellowship.

5. For joining the Fellowship at this Institute, you will be paid travel expenses as per Government norms. The same norm will be apply when you leave the Institute at the end of your term.

6. You are expected to complete your research project within the duration of your Fellowship and submit a monograph to the Institute before the period of Fellowship is over. The Institute shall have the first right of its publication as we are keen that the findings of your research are made accessible to the wider world of scholarship.
7. As a Fellowship, you will be expected to prepare your manuscript for submission to the Institute on the computer available in the Institute. If, for some unavoidable reasons, you might have to take outside help for preparation of the manuscript for submission, prior approval, giving the details of the work and estimated expenditure, will be necessary and the charges on this account will be considered for reimbursement as per the Institute rules.
8. You are also informed that any Fellow who leaves his or her Fellowship prematurely without approval of the Governing Body or who does not submit the end-product of his or her research to the Institute, will not subsequently be associated with the academic programmes of the Institute.
9. The Institute has a well equipped library. You are, however, advised to bring such special books in your respective field of research as you might possess when coming to the institute. Suggestions for acquiring books needed for your work will be most welcome. A list of such books giving full particulars i.e. title, author, publisher, date of publication etc. may be sent to the Librarian of the Institute and every endeavour will be made to procure them for you.
10. The Institute is residential in character. Besides working for your research project you will be expected to participate in discussions, seminars, symposia and workshops organised by the Institute from time to time.
11. A copy of the Notes for the Guidance of Fellows which will give an idea of the aims and objectives of the Institute and the facilities that are available is enclosed for your information.
12. May I request you to kindly communicate your acceptance of the award of Fellowship offered by the Institute within a fortnight from the date of receipt of this letter.
13. You are requested to join the Institute preferably by 15th June, 1998.
