

(ii) Deputation of Prof. M.Miri to I.I.A.S., Shimla

.....

The Executive Council vide resolution No.EC:91:96:6:3:(vi) held on 7.12.96 approved the extension of deputation for a period of two years only i.e. w.e.f. 11.9.96 to 10.9.98 and a further resolved that extension of one more year be referred to the M.H.R.D.

The matter has been referred to M.H.R.D. vide office letter dated February 4, 1997 and reply has been received vide their letter No.F.8-9/97-Desk(U) dated March 11, 1997 and placed at Annexure I & II, in which the M.H.R.D. has conveyed no objections to the extension of deputation period of Prof. Mrinal miri with I.I.A.S., by another 3 years i.e. upto 10.9.1999, subject to relevant rules of the University laid down in this regard.

The University ordinance is completely silent with regard to the terms and conditions of deputation of teachers. However, as per the Swamy's Compilation of FR/SK, Central Rules the term of deputation of Prof. Mrinal miri may be considered under Clause 8.3 (ii) which is reproduced below:-

Tenure of Deputation:-

- 8.1 The period of deputation shall be subject to a maximum of three years in all cases except for those posts where a longer period of tenure is prescribed in the Recruitment Rules.
- 8.2. The Administrative Ministries may grant extension beyond this limit up to one year, after obtaining orders of their Secretary, in cases where such extension is considered necessary in public interest.
- 8.3. The borrowing Ministries/Departments may extend the period of deputation for the fifth year or for the second year in excess of the period prescribed in the Recruitment Rules, where absolutely necessary, subject to the following conditions:-
- (i) While according extension for the fifth year or the second year in excess of the period prescribed in the Recruitment Rules, the directive issued for rigid application of the tenure rules should be taken into consideration and only in rare and exceptional circumstances, such extension should be granted.

(ii) The extension should be strictly in public interest and with the specific prior approval of the concerned Minister in the borrowing Ministry/Department.

(iii) Where such extension is granted, it would be on the specific understanding that the officer would not be entitled to draw deputation (duty) allowance.

(iv) The extension would be subject to the prior approval of the lending organisation of the officer on deputation, and wherever necessary, the U.P.S.C.

The matter is reported to the Council for consideration.

The Council further RESOLVED that he should also give an undertaking that he will continue to pay his Provident Fund Contributions to NEHU every month.
