

## DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENTS

### PLANNING DEPARTMENT

The Planning Department of the University has been established to make the vision plan for the overall development of the University, for the academic, infrastructure development and welfare activities.

The year 2006-2007 being the last year of the Xth Plan period, much development activities took place in the University. During this year large quantum of development grant was received by the University. Some of them are as under :

The original Xth Plan allocation of Rs. 14.81 crores has been revised to Rs. 42.52 crores and almost the entire amount has been received by the University. During this year, the University also received grant for establishment of School of Technology and School of Management and the academic activities of the School of Technology and School of Management have already started. These apart, grants have been received for infrastructure development of the Tura Campus for completion of NLCPR projects. These grants were beyond the Xth Plan grant of Rs. 42.52 crores.

During this year, the UGC sanctioned an Academic Staff College for NEHU and for which, the first instalment of grant has been received. The Academic Staff College has started functioning. All the Research proposals and infrastructure development in three sectors submitted to the UGC under the programme "University with Potential for Excellence" has been approved and the first instalment of the grant has since been received. During this year, the University has received additional grant for purchase of laboratory equipments and also for construction of a new 100 seated Guest House. All the development activities are going on in full swing, particularly in the area of construction. The Planning Department hopes that once all the infrastructure projects are completed, the University will have an advanced look.

### COLLEGE DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL

The College Development Council was established with the objective to provide a leadership role and extend help, guidance and advice to the Colleges admitted to the privileges of the University.

During the year 2006-07, the CDC as per UGC rules appointed Experts and V.C's nominees to attend Committees for Selection of Lecturers/Principals and for placement Committees in the affiliated colleges.

**Highlight :**

College Development Council with 22 members has become functional. The first meeting of the Council was held on 19 June 2006.

The College Development Council organised a Conference of Principals on 11 May 2006, where matters relating to affiliation, admission of students and examinations were discussed.

The CDC organized a one day workshop for Principals and senior lecturers on "Quality Teaching and Learning in Institutions of Higher Education", on 10 November 2006. The Workshop was sponsored by the NAAC, Bangalore and NEHU, Shillong.

Three Colleges were newly affiliated to this University, one of which was affiliated as per the provisions of the National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions Act. The total number of affiliated colleges is now 59.
