Subject: Pay Scales and Career Advancement for Project Officers and qualifications for appointment to core staff for Adult and Continuing Education Programmes.

Sir,

I am directed to say that the Commission has been informing the Universities from time to time that the staff working in the Department/Centre for Adult and Continuing Education and Extension Programmes may be treated at par with other teaching staff working in other faculties of the University.

The Commission vide its letter No.F.1-14/85(NHE) date 17.5.1989 conveyed to the universities that the core staff of the department/centre of Adult and Continuing Education and Extension Programmes, i.e. the Director, Assistant Director and Project Officer shall be given the scales of pay corresponding to the scales of pay of the Professors, Readers and Lecturers respectively at par with the scheme of revised scales of pay for teachers, w.e.f. 1.1.1986. In the said circular, it was intimated that the details of the career advancement to Project Officers were being worked out and would be communicated later.

In the revised guidelines on Total Literacy Campaign and Adult and Continuing Education Programmes circulated to the universities in May, 1992, it was explicitly made clear that the scales of the pay of the staff sanctioned by the UGC for Departments of Adult Education should be the same as for any other teaching department faculty in the University. The incumbents working in the Department of Adult Education should have the same status and facilities as admissible to those working in other Departments of the university except that adult education department be non-vocational. The Commission has now decided that the post of Project Officers for the Adult and Continuing Education and Extension (including Population Education) in the universities shall also carry besides the scale of Rs.2200-4000/-, the scheme of career advancement with the benefit of senior grade (Rs.3000-5000) and select in grade (Rs.3700-5300) as admissible to lecturers working in other faculties in universities, colleges and subject to the same conditions. The grant of the senior grade and the selection grade of pay to the Project Officers shall be subject to fulfilment of the same terms and conditions as are applicable for lecturers in other faculties in the universities. Also, the qualifications for recruitment of Project Officers, Assistant Directors and Director would also be the same for a Lecturers, Readers and Professors respectively.
