The Vice-Chancellor in term of provision under Statute 6 (1) of the NEHU Act, 1973 has now appointed Prof (Mrs) S. Miri, Department of Philosophy the next senior-most professor from the School as Dean, School of Humanities & Education for a period of 3 (three) years w.e.f. the end of the current semester ending December 2001.
