- (i) Implementation of reservation Policy for SC/ST in Central Universities.

The University Grants Commission vide their letter No.F.1-8/96(SC/ST) dt.16th October,1996(Annexure-'A') has conveyed that in its meeting held on 31st July,1996 the Commission considered the Status of implementation of the reservation policy in favour of the SCs/STs in Central Universities and Deemed to be Universities maintained by the University Grants Commission.

One of the decision besides other, is that the Universities may be asked to make suitable amendment in their Acts and Statutes for implementation of the reservation policy for SCs/STs.

The Vice-Chancellor desires that this matter be brought to the Executive Council.

The matter is therefore placed before the Council for consideration.

Subject :- Implementation of reservation policy for Scheduled
Castes/Scheduled Tribes in Central Universities-reg,

Sir,

At its meeting held on 31st July, 1996 the Commission considered the status of implementation of the reservation policy in favour of the SCs/STs in Central Universities and Deemed to be Universities maintained by UGC and, interalia, decided as under :-

1. Greater thrust should be given for the implementation of reservations in admissions particularly in the courses in specialised disciplines. This would help in greater availability of qualified Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes personnel for teaching posts in these disciplines.
2. The issue relating to decision to make reservations either discipline-wise, or subject-wise or department-wise, for implementation of the reservation policy may be left to each university, depending on their size and situation.
3. Special recruitment drive may be launched to fill the teaching and non-teaching reserved positions and the UGC may be intimated about the steps taken by the University. A copy of advertisement, appearing in the various newspapers, should be sent to the UGC. The posts falling vacant should be frozen to initiate enrolment of the SC/ST teachers and staff.
4. Special drive for the admission of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes may be launched immediately. A copy of the advertisement, appearing in the various newspapers, should be sent to the UGC.

5. All Central Universities and Deemed to be universities may be requested to intimate their plan for implementation of reservation policy for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.

6. The universities may be asked to make suitable amendment in their Acts and Statutes for the implementation of the reservation policy for Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes.

The Central Universities/Deemed to be universities are are requested to take necessary action keeping in view the decisions taken by the Commission as enumerated above and action taken report sent to UGC, at an early date.

(xvi) Terms and conditions of the services of teachers slected/nominated to parliament/ State Legislator/District Council.

No:EC:93:97:6:6:(xvi): The Council RESOLVED that in terms of Clause 3 of the NEHU Regulation No:RE-6 teachers who are elected/nominated to Parliament/Assembly/District Council and are holding executive posts/jobs shall have to avail Extra Ordinary Leave for the period of holding executive posts/jobs and shall not hold any administrative position/responsibility in the University, but the period so spent will be counted for increment and seniority.

The Council further RESOLVED to amend regulations No:RE-6 by adding a new clause 4 so as to read "Such elected members to Parliament/Assembly/District Council may continue only for two terms of five years at a stretch after which they either return to the Department or one deemed to have vacated the post"
