(3) If after having paid the fees, a candidate desires the admission to be cancelled, he shall be refunded all fees and deposits, except Tuition Fee for one month, Admission fee and Enrolment fee, provided his application for withdrawal is received by the Registrar at least five clear days before the commencement of the academic session concerned.

(4) If after having paid his fees a candidate does not join the University, only the Caution Money shall be refunded to him provided his application for withdrawal is received by the Registrar not later than 15 clear days after the commencement of the academic session concerned.

(5) If a student owes any money to the University on account of any damage he may have caused to the University property, it shall be, alongwith outstanding tuition fee and fines, if any, deducted from the Caution Money due to him.
