

XII SCHEDULED CASTES/TRIBES

During the year 2001-2002 the SC/ST Cell was fully engaged in implementation of the reservation policy for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes as per the directives and guidelines issued by the Government of India from time to time. In this context, efforts have been made by the Cell to provide reservation for the SC and ST communities in all aspects as per norms of the Government of India.

Some of the major achievements during the year is as follows:

For the benefit of the students studying in colleges, the Cell placed the report and recommendation of the High Powered Committee constituted by the National Commission on inclusion of the Fundamental Rights including their history, scope and application as part of the course curriculum in the colleges and was accepted by the Academic Council and the Executive Council of the university.

The Cell for SC/ST was visited by members of the UGC Standing Committee, Shri C. Chellappan, member of the National Commission for Scheduled Castes and Tribes, New Delhi accompanied by the Director, National Commission for SCs and STs for reviewing its functioning.

To strengthen the SC/ST communities, the Statistical Assistant working in the Cell was deputed to attend the 2-Day Re-Orientation Seminar on reservation policy for SC/ST/OBC organised by the National Institute of Public Administration at Bangalore on 23rd -24th November, 2001. The seminar dealt at length with post-based roster and other important government orders for SCs, STs and OBC. The cell is now actively engaged to complete the work on post-based roster as per the guidelines of the Government of India.
