

Sub: (x) Appointment on officiating basis

Two posts of Deputy Registrars are lying vacant for quite some time past. Necessary administrative action are being taken to fill up these two posts. However, the process is likely to take some time. Meanwhile, the works allotted to those two vacant posts have been reallocated among other Deputy Registrars. But it has been experienced that the reallocation have overloaded the Deputy Registrars so as to adversely affected the office works.

At this juncture, in the interest of works, the Vice Chancellor has approved officiating appointment of the senior-most and the second senior-most Assistant Registrars i.e Shri P.K.D.Purkayastha and Shri K.Nengnong respectively to the grade of Deputy Registrar w.e.f 20.6.2002. The officiating appointment has been ordered in pursuance of the resolution of the Executive Council vide EC:108:2000:6:6(iii) dated 8.12.2000, which provide that any vacancy of a period larger than 180 days may be filled up by granting promotion on officiating basis on the basis of overall seniority in the feeder cadre, subject to condition that the officer so promoted will have to undertake the works allotted to regular post held by the officer. However, the officer will be entitled to the pay/salary of the higher post. The decision of the Council came into effect on 1.1.2001. The officiating appointment granted to the officer is subject to the condition that the term of appointment will automatically fall through in the event of appointment on regular basis to the vacant posts and the appointment made to the officer on officiating basis does not bestow any right to them for a regular appointment.

The matter is placed before the Council for ratification of the appointment of the two officers, namely Shri P.K.D.Purkayastha and Shri K.Nengnong.
