

- (ix) On the Post-Graduate Diploma Course in Computer Applications at St. Anthony's College, Shillong.

The PGDCA Course was introduced in St. Anthony's College on the recommendation of the AC Vide decision No. AC:44:92:5:05(v) on the condition that the concerned Institution should apply and obtain accreditation within the period of three years, from the Department of Electronics.

Considering the above condition, the Principal had again made a request to the University to exempt the College from going for accreditation to the Department of Electronics giving justifications. This request has been put up to the E.C. for consideration.

The E.C. Vide Resolution No. EC:90:96:6:v has resolved that it will not be possible for the University to recognise the course in the absence of the accreditation from the Department of Electronics.

The above decision was conveyed to the Principal, who on receipt of the same has requested the University to review the decision taking reference from other Institutions.

Finally, the matter come up for discussion in the E.C. and the Council Vide resolution No. EC:91:5:6:(iii) reiterated the decision that the College must obtain accreditation within 15 June, 1997. This resolution was also communicated to the Principal, who on receipt of the same has submitted a letter which is self explanatory, requesting the University to suggest alternative solution to the problem faced by the College (letter enclosed).

In the meantime the Office (Examination Department) took up the matter directly with the Director of Electronics and reply to the same has been received wherein it was stated that the Director of Electronics does not give accreditation for Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Applications Course. The letter stated that "Department of Electronics does not give accreditation for Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Applications Course. However, Department of Electronics is operating a scheme namely, DCEACC Society under which Computer Training Institutes/Organisations are given accreditation for conducting specified level of courses, subject to meeting well-defined norms and criteria. There are four level of Computer Courses 'O' 'A' 'B' and 'C' level. O : a Fundamental level, A : An Advance Diploma course, B : A graduate level course and C : a Master's Degree level course".

In view of the above, provisional Permission has been granted to St. Anthony's College to continue with the Course subject to ratification by the E.C.

The matter, is therefore placed before the E.C. for ratification.

Considering the above conditions, the Principal has again made a request to the University to exempt the College from going for accreditation to the Department of Electronics giving justifications. This request has been put up to the E.C. for consideration.

The E.C. Vibe Resolution No. EC/97/50(141) reiterated that it will not be possible for the University to recommend the course in the absence of the accreditation from the Department of Electronics.
