5: 1-Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations & Rules-

- (i) Amendment to Ordinance OE-4 clause 2(1) of the Mode of Advertisement.

Prof. K.B. Powar, Secretary General, Association of Indian Universities requested the University to place the advertisement of our University for various posts and other items including admission notification in the 'University News'. The copy of the letter received from Prof. K.B. Powar is at Annexure I and the rate of the advertisement is placed at Annexure II.

Ordinance OE-4 Clause 2(1) All vacancies in academic cadres of the University shall be advertised in atleast four all India papers, one each from the eastern, Northern, Western and Southern region and at least one regional paper each of the three constituents Units of the University. However, the Executive Council in 84th meeting held on 8th December 1994 has decided that as a measure of economy, the advertisement for academic cadres be floated only in the 'Employment News' and one local newspapers of the States under the jurisdiction of NEHU. The Executive Council's resolution is at Annexure III.

In view of the above, it may kindly be decided whether the advertisement of our University for various posts can be placed in the 'University News' as requested by the General Secretary, Association of Indian Universities.

The matter is therefore, placed before the Council for consideration.

An Extract of the Minutes of the 84th meeting of the Executive Council held on 8th December, 1994.

- (iii) Floating of advertisement for vacancies in Academic Cadres.

NO:EC:84:94:6:7:(iii) : It has been resolved by the Council that as a measure of economy, advertisements for vacancies in Academic Cadres be floated only in the Employment News and in one of the local newspaper of the States under the jurisdiction of North Eastern Hill University (NEHU).

- (iii) Charge per case - Rs. 20,000/- (without payment of 50% advance as stated by him in his letter of May 1, 1997).
- (iv) Fees for drafting, affidavit, rejoinder etc - Nil.
- (v) The engagement is terminable by either party on one month's notice.
- (vi) Fifty per cent of the fees to be paid in advance.
