- (1) Permanent posting of teachers repatriated from erstwhile Mizoram Campus vis-à-vis utilization of posts.

A Committee under the Chairmanship of Prof. R.Lalthantluanga was constituted to consider the feasibility of permanent posting of the teachers repatriated from erstwhile Mizoram Campus to various Departments/Centres of the University. The Committee met on various occasions to work out the modalities for such posting. After careful consideration of the bio-data which includes subjects, disciplines, number of research papers, research activities in the recent past and area-wise specialization etc., of each of the teachers and also in consideration of the interim order dated 28.4.2005 passed by the Hon'ble High Court, Shillong Bench, the Committee made its recommendation for permanent posting of the teachers through its minutes of the meeting held on 17.2.2006. The report of the Committee may be seen at Annexure-A. On the Writ Petition filed by 13 (thirteen) teachers of the erstwhile Mizoram Campus, the Hon'ble High Court in its interim order made it clear that the respondent NEHU shall adjust the petitioners to their respective subjects as per their specialization, whenever a vacancy arises at NEHU.

In compliance with the directives issued by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India from time to time, the University eventually adjusted 28 (twenty eight) teachers against the vacant posts of different Departments/Centres and 8(eight) teachers were adjusted against supernumerary posts. Among these, two of the teachers, namely, Dr S.N.Ramanujam and Dr S.K.Jha in the recent past have been appointed through open selection as Reader and Lecturer in the Department of Zoology and Statistics respectively. Further, it may also be noted that Dr Shiva Kumar, Lecturer in Geology and Dr Girindra Kumar, Reader in Geography, who have initially opted to remain with NEHU been appointed by the Mizoram University in concerned Department. Of late, the Mizoram University intimated NEHU that they are considering the confirmation of service in respect of Dr Shiva Kumar and Dr Girindra Kumar and accordingly sought the consent of this University. The University has given its consent subject to the condition that the aforesaid teachers submit their technical resignation from the post held by them in NEHU. However, further information from Mizoram University is still awaited. In view of these developments, some changes have been made on utilization of posts to accommodate the teachers from erstwhile Mizoram Campus. The detailed proposed permanent posting of the teachers and utilization of posts may be read as under:-

Minutes of the Committee for Permanent Posting of the Repatriated Teachers from erstwhile Mizoram Campus and Pachhunga University College, Aizawl.

In view of the representations received vis-à-vis appointment of some of the teachers of erstwhile Mizoram Campus (through open selection) to various departments, the Committee found it necessary to review the entire matter with regard to the permanent posting of the teachers, repatriated from Mizoram.

The Committee took into consideration the Court Interim Order dated 28.4.2005 passed by the Hon'ble High Court (Shillong Bench) and the disciplines, subjects, number of research papers, research activities in the recent past, area of specializations, etc. of each of the teachers and also the faculty requirement of proposed School of Technology and different Centres of Studies.

Keeping the above yardsticks in view, the Committee recommends the permanent posting of the teachers as detailed below:-
