- (ix) Release of Kum. Esther Booth, Assistant Editor on her resignation.

Kum Esther Booth tendered her resignation on 20.6.88 presumably on grounds of ill health for which she had been absenting herself from duty since October, 1987.

While accepting the resignation, the Vice-Chancellor, in consideration of the grounds of ill health, decided to release her with effect from 20. 6. 88(AN) thus waiving the statutory requirement of one month's notice on resignation or remittance of one month's pay in lieu thereof.

The matter is placed before the Council for ratification.

(x) Resignation tendered by Shri Lal
~~Rinawma~~, Lecturer, Department of History.

Shri ~~Lal Rinawma~~ was appointed Lecturer in the department of History with effect from March 5, 1982, on adhoc basis against the leave vacancy vice Smt. M.Momin proceeded on E.O.L for two years and extended for another period of one year. On the expiry of the E.O.L of Smt. M.Momin, his temporary appointment had been extended against the leave vacancy caused by Shri S.Chawla, Lecturer, with effect from 5.1.84, and deemed to have vacated the post with effect from ~~7.10.85~~. As such, the services of Shri ~~L.Rinawma~~ is continuously on temporary basis without break from 1982 to date.

Although Shri ~~L.Rinawma~~ had appeared the Selection Committees but was not recommended for regular appointment. Shri ~~L.Rinawma~~ availed Earned-Leave for a period of 50 days with effect from 18.3.88 to 6.5.88. On the expiry of the Earned-Leave, he informed the University that he had been offered the post of Principal of Aizawl, North-College, and had decided to accept the appointment.

In view of the above, he tendered resignation and request the University to accept his resignation and to release him with effect from May 6, 1988, the date of expiry of Earned-leave.

Since his services is still on adhoc basis, the Vice-Chancellor accepted his resignation and released him with effect from May 6, 1988, subject to clearance of all dues.

The matter is therefore placed before the Council for ratification.

- (xi) Appointment of Shri T.C. Hazarika as Executive Engineer on contract basis.

Shri T.C. Hazarika, erstwhile Executive Engineer of NEHU on deputation, retired from the Govt. of Meghalaya services with effect from 30. 4. 88(B.N).

Since Shri Hazarika's earlier services in this University was found to be satisfactory and the University being in dire need of engineers, the Vice-Chancellor has appointed Shri Hazarika as Executive Engineer on contract basis with effect from 20. 5. 88(FN) initially for a period of 1(one)year.

The matter is placed before the Council for ratification.

- (xii) Grant of study leave to Smt. Rama Mishra, Assistant Librarian.

Smt. Rama Mishra, Assistant Librarian, had applied for study leave for one year with effect from 17. 8. 88 for pursuing studies at the Department of Library & Information Science, NEHU, leading to the award of the M.Lib.Sc. Degree.

As Smt. Mishra has rendered more than five years service in this University and is eligible for grant of study leave in terms of the provisions of the CCS(Leave)Rules, the Vice-Chancellor has accordingly granted her study leave with effect from 17. 8. 88 for a period of one year.

(i) INTRODUCTION OF 5-DAY WEEK.

The Executive Council in its 46th meeting considered the question of introduction of 5-day week in the Administrative and Academic Departments of the University on receipt of the report of the Committee constituted by the University to examine the feasibility of its implementation and RESOLVED that a final decision may be taken after the conference of the Vice-Chancellors of Central Universities discussed the matter. The University Grants Commission has now communicated the decision arrived at in the meeting of the Committee of Vice-Chancellors of Central Universities held on the 2nd June, 1988, which states that the Universities may take their own decision. The letter No.F.1-41/85 (NP-I) dated the 11th August, 1988 is placed at Annexure 'A'.

The report of the Committee constituted by the University is at Annexure 'B'.

The matter is put up for consideration of the Council.

In the meeting to discuss introduction of five day week held on the 3rd September, 1985, the following members were present.

1. Shri H.W.T.Syiem, Officer on Special Duty.
2. Prof. R.R.Mishra, Dean, School of Life Sciences.
3. Prof. T.S.B.Narasaraju, Dean, School of Physical Sciences.
4. Mrs. M.R.Mawlong, Director of Public Instruction, Meghalaya, Shillong.
5. Shri K.J.S. Prasada Rao, Deputy Registrar (Administration)

The view of the various Deans are as follows :

1. Dean, School of Education - The five day week could be introduced only in the second and fourth weeks of the month. In the remaining weeks the six day week schedule may be followed.
2. Dean, School of Physical Sciences - A meeting of members of the the School of Physical Sciences were in favour of the introduction of five day week. Facilities may be created for keeping the departmental Libraries open on Saturdays, and if possible on Sunday also.

The RSIC may be kept opened on Saturdays for use of their equipment.

Supporting staff may be kept available on Saturdays in case of necessity.

3. Dean, School of Life Sciences - The Dean, School of Life Sciences, has worked out that introduction of the five day week with working hours from 9.00 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. with a 30 minute launch break will provide thirtyfive teaching hours per week as against the present number of 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours. Hence, introduction of the five day week would result in more teaching hours available as per his calculations. This would indicate that ;

(a) effective teaching time per semester is not affected. Infact there is a gain.

(b) Students get the whole of Saturday available for Library consultation. At present this is not available.

(c) The faculty could have an additional free day for their own research work. Thus, the total academic effectiveness of the students and faculty will be enhanced.

The Dean, School of Life Sciences has suggested that the Library should remain open on Saturdays.

4. Dean, School of Social Sciences - The Dean, School of Social Sciences could not attend the meeting as he was engaged in another meeting. However, as subsequently discussed with him, he stated that the opinion of the teachers in the School of Social Sciences was largely in favour of the introduction of the five day week. He agreed with the calculations of working hours as worked out by the Dean, School of Life Sciences.

The Dean, School of Physical Sciences also agreed with the calculations as worked out by the Dean, School of Life Sciences.

It would, therefore, appear that the Deans are in favour of introduction of the five day week in the University. They, however, were generally of the view that the Library should be kept opened on Saturdays. This was discussed separately with the Librarian who stated that the five day week could not be made applicable to the Library staff. He agreed to keep the Library opened on Saturdays and possibly on Sundays, but for this it will necessary to prepare a roster duty and means will have to be devised by which staff working on holidays be given extra-remuneration and compensatory leave be granted. The suggestion seem reasonable.

Thus, with these facts available, the Committee was of the view that introduction of the five day week is feasible in all the Departments of the University. The advantages of the five day week are :

1. With the increase working hours, there will be more teaching hours available.
2. Students will have more time to consult the Library on Saturdays and possibly Sundays.

3. Teaching staff will be able to devote at least one day to their own research work.

4. There will be general enhancement of academic effectiveness among students and faculty.

A problem arise in the fact that the University Grants Commission has stipulated that there should be a minimum of ninety working days in a semester. However, if the number of working hours is considered, working hours with the introduction of the five day week will be more than what is prevailing under the present system. However, if the ninety working days are to be insisted, the Committee suggested that this can be met by reducing the winter holidays and summer vacation. If the five day week is introduced, there would be approximately 80 to 85 working days in each semester. Thus, the deficit of five days in each semester can be met by the following measures :

1. Starting the academic session around the 20th February instead of 1st March as at present. This is feasible since Schools and Colleges in Shillong re-opens after the winter vacation around the 15th February.

2. The mid-term holidays after the end of the first semester can be reduced to one week as against fifteen days as at present thus, the Committee recommends introduction of the five day week in both the teaching and non teaching Departments in the University.

Impersonation at the Pre-University (Arts) Examination, 1988.

The Principal, St. Anthony's College, Shillong, reported that Sri. Kuldip Sing Saini (Roll No. 12101) a P.U. (Arts) candidate sent a friend of his to write the Economics II for him on 25. 3. 88. The boy named the person as 'Kamal', a student of P.G.T. College, Shillong.

From the records, it is found that there is a student named Kamal Kumar Chopra who sat for the B.Ed. Examination from P.G.T. College in March 1988. The Committee verified his handwriting with that in Economics II of Sr. Kuldip Sing Saini and observed similarities. Appropriate punishment under Clause V of the ordinance was awarded to Sri. Kuldip Sing Saini.

The Ordinance does not provide what punishment is to be awarded to a person who is engaged for impersonation. The Discipline Committee has decided to refer the matter to the Executive Council for decision.

The case is, therefore, submitted to the Executive Council for consideration and decision.

(ii) Selection Committees -

So also the Registrar Jamia Milia Islamia informed that its Executive Council vide resolution No.2 dated 3.9.87 has approved for the transfer of his services on conditions that NEHU pays to JMI the capitalised value of Pension and Gratuity for the services rendered by Dr Waseem in NEHU.

Jamia Milia Isliaamia was informed that as per Centr 1 University Retirement Benefit Rules liability of pension and gratuity for the period that Dr Waseem was in NEHU is to be borne by the Institution from which the employee finally retires.

The matter regarding the release of Dr Waseem and transfer of services as per CURB Rules is placed before the Council for consideration.

- (viii) Upgradation of Dr. Imdad Hussain's appointment in the Academic Staff College from Jt. Director to Director.

Dr. Imdad Hussain was appointed Joint Director in the Academic Staff College with effect from 1. 3. 88 as he was then a Reader in the Department of History to which he retains his lien.

However, the Executive Council, in its 61st meeting held on 2. 5. 88 approved the appointment of Dr. Hussain as professor through MPS retrospectively from 2.4.87.

In view of his being appointed professor, Dr. Hussain has represented that his appointment in the academic Staff College be upgraded to Director with effect from 1. 3. 88 or with effect from 2. 5. 88, the date the Executive Council decided his appointment as Professor. It may also be stated here that the Local Executive Council in its 19th meeting held on 6. 7. 88 had decided to appoint Shri S.K.A. John as Director, A.S.C. Shri John has accepted the offer and will be joining at the end of October, 1988.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.

- (ix) Re-instatement of Dr. K.J. Joseph, Reader, Deptt. of Education, NEHU.

In pursuance of the High Court Judgement and Order in Civil Rule No.953/82 and resolution of the 3rd Emergent Meeting of the Executive Council, NEHU on 23rd July, 1988, Dr. K.J. Joseph, Reader, Deptt. of Education, NEHU, who was removed from service from 16th July, 1982 has been re-instated with immediate effect vide office order No. 10-10/Estt.II/75(Vol.II)/231 dated 29th August, 1988.

Consequent upon the re-instatement, the following matters will have to be regulated and specific order issued;

1. Regulation of the pay and allowances for the period from 16.7.82 to 29.8.88.
2. Whether or not the said period be treated as period spent on duty.
3. Post against which Dr. K.J. Joseph is to be accommodated as the post earlier occupied by him has since been filled up.

At present there is no vacancy of Reader in the Deptt. of Education, NEHU, Shillong.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.

(x) Seniority list -determination of Seniority in respect of Dr. (Mrs) T. Ao and Dr. R.P.Sharma, Readers, Deptt. of English, NEHU, Shillong.

Dr. (Mrs) T. Ao, Reader, Deptt. of English, NEHU, has submitted a representation in connection with the determination of her seniority with that of her colleague Dr. R.P.Sharma. (Vide Annexure - "A").

Dr. (Mrs) T. Ao was selected Reader through an open selection and Dr. R.P.Sharma through the Merit Promotion Scheme.

The Executive Council in its 58 meeting resolved that a candidate on being assessed suitable for promotion shall be promoted with effect from the date of eligibility irrespective of the date on which the Selection Committee was held. Accordingly, Dr. R.P.Sharma, who was considered for promotion under the Merit Promotion Scheme in an interview held on 28.6.84 was promoted with effect from 21.3.83 i.e. date of completion of eight years service in a grade. It may be mentioned that Dr. R.P.Sharma's previous service before joining NEHU was taken into consideration while determining the 8 years period. As per Merit Promotion Scheme guidelines a candidate should complete at least 4 years in the institution where he/she is being considered for promotion. Dr. Sharma joined NEHU as Lecturer on 21.3.79 and thus he completed 4 years on 21.3.83.

Dr. (Mrs) T. Ao was selected Reader in an interview held on 24.9.83 which was an open selection. She was offered the post and joined on 20.10.83. It may be mentioned that Dr. R.P.Sharma was also one of the candidates and he appeared together with Dr. (Mrs) Ao but was not selected.

In the draft seniority list circulated, Dr. R.P.Sharma was shown as senior to Dr. (Mrs) T. Ao i.e. Dr. Sharma's date of joining was shown w.e.f. 21.3.83 and Dr. (Mrs) Ao's w.e.f. 20.10.83.

It may be seen from the above that Dr. R. P. Sharma, who was selected as Reader under the Merit Promotion Scheme much later than Dr. (Mrs) Ao, had superseded Dr. (Mrs) Ao affecting her adversely.

The Executive Council in its 56th meeting resolved that the date of joining the post should be taken for the purpose of seniority while other benefits should continue to be drawn from the date of eligibility. Some of the teachers promoted under the Merit Promotion Scheme represented against the above decision and as such another resolution as mentioned in para 3 above, was adopted by the Executive Council in its 58th meeting.

It is seen from the appointments that promotion under Merit Promotion Scheme has become more beneficial than open selection when, perhaps more weight should be given to open selection.

In the instant case when both had faced the same open selection Dr. (Ms) Ao, who was selected, may be senior to Dr. Sharma, who was not selected. However, as per the Executive Council Resolution in the 58th meeting Dr. R.P. Sharma was made senior to Dr. (Ms) Ao giving the benefit of the Merit Promotion Scheme.

The representation of Dr. (Ms) T. Ao is therefore, placed before the Council for consideration as to how the seniority is to be determined.

Sub:- Interse Seniority in the English Department.

Sir,

I had filed a representation earlier dated 28.3.87 with regard to my seniority as Reader in the English Department in protest against the error shown in the Draft Seniority List of Readers in NEHU. But as of date the University has failed to redress my grievance.

My claim is that I am senior as Reader in the Department to Dr.R.P.Sharma whereas in the said list it is shown that he is senior to me. I had stated this in my earlier representation and hereby reiterate the same on the following grounds:

- (a) I appeared before the selection Committee of the U.G.C. for a Reader's post in the English Department at New Delhi on 24th September 1983. Dr.R.P. Sharma too appeared before the said Committee for the same post on the same day. We were both Lecturers in the English Department at that time. I was selected by the Committee for the post whereas Dr.R.P.Sharma was not. I took charge as Reader in the English Department on 20th October 1983 while Dr.Sharma continued as a Lecturer.
- (b) Under the Merit Promotion Scheme, the post of Lecturer in the Department held by Dr.R.P.Sharma was up-graded to that of a Reader and thus he became a Reader in August 1984, some 11(eleven) months after my joining as Reader.
- (c) I was selected as a Reader on competitive, direct and regular recruitment basis. It is difficult to understand how a person who became a Reader 11(eleven) months, later under the MPS could be placed senior to me by 7(seven) months as shown in the Draft Seniority List.
- (d) Just as my seniority as a Reader has been counted from the date of my joining, so also the seniority of Dr.R.P. Sharma should be counted from the date of his joining as Reader.

(e) I am not aware of any rule which empowers fixation of seniority with retrospective effect as has been done in the case of Dr.R.P. Sharma. I do not think that any such rule would exist, because that will be in violation of natural justice.

(f) Even while making recruitment to All India Services, a promotee in the same year, month and date, vis-a-vis a regular, direct recruit into the cadre, is always placed below the regular candidate in the order of seniority.

I am much concerned about this matter of fixation of interse seniority. I am convinced that my claim is fair and justified because a person who continued to be a Lecturer for 11(eleven) months after I joined as Reader, can never, by any stretch of the imagination be placed above me in the Seniority List of Readers.

I would request you to kindly examine this matter and oblige me by communicating the final decision of the University regarding my claim.

- 11) Grant of Study Leave in respect of Miss. E. Jyrwa, Junior Library Assistant.

Miss. E. Jyrwa, who was appointed as JLA in the Central Library, NEHU, Shillong on purely temporary & adhoc basis with effect from 4.5.83 to 16.11.84 as per orders issued from time to time and whose services were regularised temporarily w.e.f. 17.6.84, applied, vide her application dt. 17.6.88, for grant of study leave for a period of one year w.e.f. 18.7.88 to 17.7.89 to prosecute a course of study for obtaining Ph.D. after having qualified for the Degrees of Master of Arts & M.Phil. in Political Science.

In this connection, Rule 50(3) of the Central Civil Service (Leave) Rule, 1972, provides that study leave shall not be granted unless :-

- (i) it is certified by the authority competent to grant leave that the proposed course of study or training shall be of definite advantage from the point of view of public interests;
- (ii) it is for prosecution of studies in subjects other than academic or literary subject:

In view of the above, though the Librarian, NEHU, Shillong, in his recommendations, certified that the above course of study to be undertaken by Miss. Jyrwa, would be useful for Library service, the study leave as applied by her, was not admissible as the study for Ph.D. is not other than academic subject.

But, keeping in view the aims and objectives of the University which aims at disseminating and advancing knowledge by providing instructional and research facilities in such branches of learning as it may deem fit, to pay special attention to the improvement of the social and economic conditions and welfare of the people of the Hill Areas of the North Eastern Region, and, in particular, their intellectual, academic and cultural advancement, the benefit of the provisions as laid down under the same rule and on the same subject, but, applicable to the employees belonging to the Indian Economic

Service or Indian Statistical Service only where an employee can be granted study leave for prosecuting a course of study for obtaining Ph.D., on a research thesis, if the subject of research and the Institution at which such research are to be undertaken are approved and certified by the competent authority that such study will be valuable in the matter of increasing the efficiency of the employee in the performance of his/her duties as a member of the Indian Economic Service or the Indian Statistical Service as the case may be, were extended to Miss. Jyrwa and on the approval of the Vice-Chancellor, WBU, Shillong, she was granted the above study leave as applied by her on the condition that, in case, the above study leave as granted to her, is not considered and approved by the Executive Council, the entire period so granted to her as study leave would be regularised as leave of the kind due.

Hence, the matter is, now, placed before the Council for favour of consideration.

- iii) Grant of Extra-Ordinary Leave to
Dr. Jagdish Chand, Lecturer in
Deptt. of Education, NEHU, Nagaland
Campus.

Dr. Jagdish Chand, Lecturer, Deptt. of Education, NEHU, Nagaland Campus, Kohima, has been selected for appointment as Reader in Arunachal University, Itanagar.

Dr. Jagdish Chand has requested for grant of two years Extra-Ordinary Leave to enable him to join the Arunachal University. The NEHU Office, Nagaland Campus has released Dr. J. Chand with effect from 31.7.88(A.N) in anticipation of approval, as the application of Dr. J. Chand for the said post was duly forwarded by this University.

Dr. Jagdish Chand joined NEHU on 28.2.80 as Lecturer and has since been confirmed in the post.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.

- iv) Sanction of Extra-Ordinary-Leave to Dr. M.A. Sudhir for 2(two) years.

Dr. M.A. Sudhir Kumar, Reader, Deptt. of Education, NEHU, Mizoram Campus, Aizawl has been selected for appointment as Professor of Education in Arunachal University, Itanagar.

In this connection, Dr. Sudhir Kumar has requested for grant of three years Extra-Ordinary-Leave for enabling him to join at Arunachal University. The application of Dr. Sudhir Kumar for the said post was duly forwarded by this University. He joined this University as Reader on 24.11.83 and has since been confirmed in the post.

The matter is placed before the Council for its consideration under Ordinance OE.6:8(iii) governing ~~of~~ Extra-Ordinary Leave, extract of which is given below:

(iii) (a) The Executive Council may also grant, at its discretion extra-ordinary-leave to a permanent teacher who have been selected for a teaching or research assignment in a University, a Research Institute or other similar important institution provided he has served the University for a period of at least three years and the application has been sent through and forwarded by the University;

(b) The leave in such cases shall not exceed a maximum period of two years;

(c) Notwithstanding any other leave which may be due to a teacher ~~of~~ the entire period for which the teacher holds the appointment out-side the University shall be without pay; and

(d) The period so spent shall not be counted for increment but shall count for seniority. The period shall not also count for pension-ary/contributory provident fund benefits unless the pension/contributory provident fund contributions are paid by the teacher or the foreign employer.

Provided that no such leave shall be granted until after the expiry of five years after return from the previous spell of extra-ordinary-leave or three years after study or sabbatical leave. If the teacher does not resume his duties in the University at the end of the period of extra-ordinary-leave granted to him, he shall be treated as having resigned the post held by him in the University.

- (iv) Calculation of Interest on arrears of Pay credited to GPF/CPF and on arrear subscription, if any, credited to those A/cs as a result of Revision of Pay Scales w.e.f. 1.1.86.

Consequent-upon the implementation of the Revised Pay Scales retrospectively w.e.f. 1.1.86 with the stipulation that arrears of pay w.e.f. 1.1.86 to 31.3.86 shall be credited compulsorily to Provident Funds Accounts, Government of India as per OM No. 20(10) -P & PW/8-E dated 25.9.86 decided to grant interest on the arrears of Pay so credited to Fund A/c w.e.f. 1.10.86 in respect of Group 'B' 'C' and 'D' Staff, while in respect of Group 'A' Officers this was allowed to be calculated w.e.f. 1.4.87 as per OM of even no. dated 22.3.88.

The justification behind the fixation of two different dates i.e. 1.10.86 for Group 'B' 'C' and 'D' and 1.4.87 for Group 'A' Officers could be seen in the Government OM dated 22.3.88. The reasons were that Government accepted the revised pay scales of Group 'B' 'C', 'D' Officers on 13.9.86, while the pay scales of Group 'A' Officers were accepted by Government on 17.3.87. Thus, payment of arrears of pay was fallen due in 10/86 for Group 'B', 'C' and 'D' Officers while it was due for drawal in 4/87 for group 'A' Officers.

In this context, a decision is required to be taken as to the date from which interest on arrears of pay w.e.f. 1.1.86 to 31.3.86 drawn in respect of Teachers whose pay scale was accepted by the Government sometimes in 9/87.

Again, pay scales of our Group 'A' Officers are yet to be accepted/ implemented, When the scales of these Officers are implemented the same question as to the date of interest calculation will arise.

In view of the position stated above, it may be decided whether this University may, following the Government of India's orders, finalise 1.10.87 as the date of calculation of interest in respect of arrears of pay for the period 1.1.86 to 31.3.86 so

credited to Provident Fund of Teachers whose revised scales was finalised in 9/87 by Government and therefore payment was due in 10/87, or we should adopt the date 1.4.87 as was allowed in respect of Central Government Group 'A' Officers by the Govt. of India in their OM No.20(10)-P & PW/86-E dated 22.3.88. (Copy enclosed).

If 1.10.87 is considered to be the date for calculation of interest with reference to the Teachers Pay scales, the date of effect of interest calculation in respect of our Group 'A' Officers may be considered as the 1st day of the month following the month in which Government decision in finalisation of the pay scales is taken.

The justification behind the fixation of two different dates 1.10.87 for Group 'B', 'C' and 'D' and 1.4.87 for Group 'A' Officers could be seen in the Government order dated 22.3.88. The reasons were that Government accepted the revised pay scales for Group 'B', 'C', 'D' Officers on 12.3.88, while the pay scales of Group 'A' Officers were accepted by Government on 17.3.88. Thus, payment of arrears of pay was taken due for Group 'B', 'C' and 'D' Officers while it was due for Group 'A' Officers.

In this context, a decision is required to be taken as to the date from which interest on arrears of pay will be taken. It is drawn to the attention of Teachers whose pay scales were accepted by the Government sometime in 1987. Again, pay scales of our Group 'A' Officers are yet to be accepted/implemented. When the scales of these Officers are implemented the same question as to the date of interest calculation will arise.

In view of the position stated above, it may be decided whether the University may, following the Government of India's orders, finalise the date of calculation of interest in respect of arrears of pay for the period 1.10.87 to 31.3.88.

Subject:- Deposit of arrears of pay for the period from 1.1.86 to 31.3.86 into Provident Fund account - clarifications regarding.

The undersigned is directed to say that orders regarding revision of pay of Group 'B', 'C' and 'D' employees were issued vide Ministry of Finance Resolution dated 13.8.86 allowing revision of pay scales in implementation of the recommendations of the Fourth Central Pay Commission w.e.f. 1.1.86. While arrears of pay of these employees for the period from 1.1.86 to 31.3.86 had to be deposited into P.F. account compulsorily and from April, 1986 to Sept., 86 voluntarily under this Department's O.M. of even number dated 25.9.86, interest was to be allowed on these deposits w.e.f. 1.10.86. However, decision of revision of pay scales of Group 'A' Officers was taken vide Ministry of Finance Resolution dated 13.3.87 and instructions issued vide this Department's O.M. of even number dated 17.3.87 extending the instructions contained in this Department O.M. dated 25.9.86 mutatis mutandis to Group 'A' officers requesting them also to come forward voluntarily, for credit in full or part of the arrears of their pay beyond March, 1986 upto the month upto which arrears would be paid to them in their P.F. accounts. Some points of doubt have been raised in regard to the payment of interest on the deposits of arrears of pay of Group 'A' officers etc. The matter has been considered in consultation with Ministry of Finance and the position is clarified as under :-

3. Whether arrears of pay deposited into P.F. account which were to be classified under the individual sub-head 'GPF- Arrears of pay' are available for calculating amount of temporary advances and final withdrawals under the rules and whether amount of arrears credited to the fund would be merged with the total accumulations in the P.F. account as on 31.3.86 while issuing annual statements.

In respect of Group 'B', 'CI and 'D' employees the amount of deposit into P.F. account could be reckoned for calculating admissible advance /final withdrawals on or after 1.4.87 and for Group 'A' officers the amount would be available on or after 1.4.88. Thus in respect of Group 'AI' officers the amount of deposit would be merged with total credit in the P.F. account as on 31.3.1988 and for other employees the amount so deposited was required to be merged with the total credit of the subscriber as on 31.3.87.

(v) Payment of H.R.A. to Research Scholars.

The NEHU Research Scholars have requested the Vice-Chancellor to allow payment of H.R.A. at par with the teachers and employees of this University w.e.f. November, 1984 as spelt out in UGC letter No.21-1/84(RF-I) dated 12.11.84, an extract of which is placed at Annexure - 'A'.

The DST vide O.M. No. 12(1)/76-GRS dated 26.5.88 and the CSIR vide letter No. 13/1/88-EMR-I dated 22.6.88 has agreed to allow to all categories of JRF/SRF/RA House Rent is applicable to the academic staff of their Institution where they are working. For this purpose, the fellowship amounts for JRF/SRF/RA has been taken as Basic Pay.

The UGC vide letter No. 21-1/84(RF-I) dated 12.11.84 has instructed that Single Seated flat type a accommodation should be provided to all Research Fellows and Associates, as far as possible. In case the Research Fellows and Associates, not accommodated as above, they would be entitled to HRA on the same Basic as admissible to teachers receiving equivalent salary.

In their letter No. F.5-76/75(RF-II) dated 21.12.87 the UGC has mentioned that all Research Fellows/Associates who have not provided with single seated flat type accommodation, but have been accommodated in a hostel may be reimbursed hostel fee to the extent of HRA as is admissible to staff of the University drawing equivalent pay subject to a maximum of Rs. 150/- p.m. and this will be effective from 20.2.86.

The Commission again in their letter No.F.3-36/87(SR-II) dated 16.4.88 has agreed to pay HRA @ Rs. 120/-p.m. and not Rs. 250/- on the basis of a certificate given by the UGC in one of the cases. A copy of the letter is at Annexure - 'B'.

The latest circular No. F. 12-2/86(RF/SA-I) dated 6.6.88 states that suitable hostel type accommodation may be provided to JRFs, failing which they are eligible for HRA as per rules of the University Institution. JRFs who have been provided accommodation in a hostel may be reimbursed the Hostel Fee.

In this connection at present on the basis of the above UGC letter dated 16.4.88 and on the recommendation of the 26th Finance meeting, the Research Scholars are being paid Rs. 120/-p.m. HRA w.e.f. November, 1985 vide this Department order No.G.17-2/Acad/86- 1863-68 dated 5.7.88 provisionally.

The request of Research Scholars and facts of the case are placed before Executive Council for consideration and final decision.
