Report of the Committee

In pursuance of the Academic Council resolution No:AC: 56:97:5:1(iii) adopted at the 56th meeting held on 21st and 22nd November, 1997 a visiting committee was constituted by the Academic Council to inspect the Nuclear Science Centre, NEW DELHI for its recognition as a Research Centre by North-Eastern Hill University.

The Nuclear Science Centre was inspected by the team on 29th May, 1998 and the Report of the Committee on inspection of Nuclear Science Centre, New-Delhi is placed at Annexure -'A'

The matter was placed before the 57th meeting of the Academic Council and the Council considered the Report of the Committee constituted by it to inspect the Nuclear Science Centre in Delhi for the purpose of its recognition as a Research Centre by NEHU and Resolved to approved the same.

Report of committee on inspection of Nuclear Science Centre, New-Delhi.

As per notification No:AC:56-4/Conf/97-525 dated 5.12.1997 and No:602 dated 26.2.1998 from DR(Conf), a committee consisting of Prof A L Verma, NEHU (Convener), Dr R N Sharan, NEHU(member) and Prof A K Gupta, IIT, Delhi (member) was constituted to inspect Nuclear Science Center (NSC), New Delhi for its recognition as a research centre by NEHU.

The NSC was inspected by the team on May 29, 1998 Prof A K Gupta could not join the team as he was out of station. However, as per his FAX message dated 25.5.1998, he had requested that the inspection be completed on May 29, as planned. The members had a thorough discussion with the Director and other scientists of NSC. Members also examined the bye laws etc of NSC. The team physically examined the laboratories, other experimental facilities, library, data processing facility, guest house, and other infrastructure at NSC.

The center is located in a beautiful campus which is fully funded by the UGC as an autonomous inter-University centre (Under Section 12(ccc) of UGC act of 1956). The centre provides accelerator based research facilities in nuclear sciences and allied areas to scientists and research workers from different Universities in the country. The centre has excellent research facilities, reasonably good library and books in relevant areas, good seminar complex, guest house and other supporting facilities.

The centre is recognized by JNU, New Delhi and research scholars working at NSC are awarded Ph.D degrees by JNU. About 12 research scholars (mostly NET qualified) are admitted to Ph.D programme at NSC who undergo a pre-Ph.D course work equivalent to 14 credit points. A course is normally of 40 contact hours and is equivalent to 3 credit points. After completion of the course work, student prepares a thesis proposal which is approved by the academic committee of NSC and only after that the student is registered with JNU for the Ph.D Programme.

Therefore, the committee recommends that NSC, New Delhi may be recognized as a research centre by North-Eastern Hill University.
