Dear *Vice Chancellor Sahib,*

Kindly refer to letter no. F.8-17/EMS/94/1391, dated 12th August, 1999 of the Assistant Registrar (Estate) NEHU Shillong, regarding allotment of land for setting up of Permanent Complex for Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) at Shillong. You are aware that the Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) has been functioning from a rented building for which house rent is being reimbursed by the Government of Meghalaya.

IGNOU has approached the State Government for allotment of land measuring 6 acres or so, free of cost so that they could set up a permanent complex at Shillong. The State Government has made several attempts to locate a suitable plot of land for IGNOU but nothing worthwhile has been found.

It may be mentioned here that the Government of Meghalaya had acquired 1025 acres of land and allotted to NEHU free of cost. The land allotted to NEHU is more than sufficient for the University and the land belongs to the State Government.

I have a feeling that NEHU will not be in a position to utilise all the land allotted for many years to come.

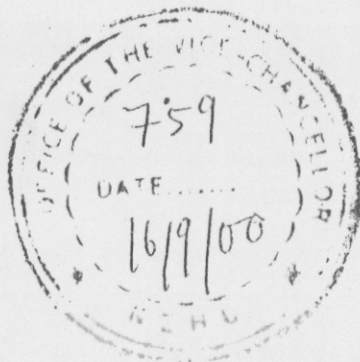


