

(vii) Appointment of Shri. H. Syiem as
 Consultant to function as University Engineer
 in the Campus Development

The Executive Council in its 103rd meeting vide resolution No:EC:103:99:3:(ii) held on 25th June, 99 has considered the action taken in appointing Shri. H. Syiem as University Engineer on a part-time basis on a consolidated honorarium of Rs. 4000/- plus Rs. 1500/- as P.O.L expenses and RESOLVED to ratify the same. Shri. H. Syiem in his letter dated 25th February 2000 has informed the Vice-Chancellor, that he will be retiring from the State Government on 31st March 2000 and has requested that he may be allowed to continue as University Engineer in NEHU on full time basis with effect from 31st March 2000. The Vice-Chancellor has considered the appointment of Shri. H. Syiem to the post of Consultant for a period of one year with a provision for extension upto 3(three) years and he will be functioning as an University Engineer. Shri. H. Syiem has put forward the following terms and conditions :-

1. The consolidated pay of Rs. 10,000/- per month offered by NEHU may please be enhanced to Rs.12,000/- per month for the present with an enhancement to any mutually agreed consolidated pay per month in the second and also in the third year, if applicable.
2. The other facilities like, residential, telephone and vehicle to be provided.
3. The Casual Leave and Earned Leave as applicable to the regular employees of the NEHU to be allowed to the undersigned.
4. Facilities for C.P.F may please be allowed.
5. Medical facilities may also be allowed.
6. T.A or D.A to be paid by NEHU for official duty outside Shillong.

The matter was examined and it was decided that the consolidated pay of Shri. H. Syiem may be enhanced from Rs.10,000/- to Rs. 12,000/- as approved by the Vice-Chancellor.

- (i) He will be allowed a vehicle as in the case of Statutory Officer in the University. Since the University is governed by the Central Government Rules and Regulations, no P.O.L/Mobil oil will be provided separately as allotted to the University Engineer and to be used for official purposes only.
- (ii) The period of contract shall be initially for a period of one year with a provision of extension upto three years.
- (iii) His Contrölling Officer will be the Vice-Chancellor, from whom, he will take order directly.
- (iv) He shall be provided with a telephone, which will be used by him for official purposes and the expenditure to be borne by the University.
- (v) He shall be entitled to Casual Leave and Earned Leave as applicable under the Government of India Rules to superannuated government employees.
- (vi) He shall be allowed to subscribe to the Contributory Provident Fund, after his completion of one year subject that his services is extended upto the third year.
- (vii) He shall be eligible for any concession in relation to medical attendance and treatment, as may be prescribed by the University.
- (viii) He shall be entitled to travelling allowance and daily allowance on the scale provided in the scales of the University for the time being in force and applicable in his case.

Shri. H. Syiem assumed duty on 1st April 2000(FN) for information of the Council Shri. H. Syiem date of birth is 1st March 1941 and has completed 59 years as on 1.4.2000.

- (iv) He shall be provided with a telephone, which will be used by him for official purposes and the expenditure to be borne by the University.

(i) Proposal for amendment to the Constitution of the NEHU Sports Board.

EC:106:2000:5:1: (i): The Council considered the amendment of Clause 1 :2: (v) and 1:6 (v) of the Constitution of the Sports Board relating to contingency and diet charges respectively of the players and RESOLVED that while the diet charges may be approved at the enhanced rate of Rs.70/- per day per player the contingency charges at the enhanced rate of Rs.150 per player be accepted in principle subject to approval by the Finance Committee.
