(II) Managment of Colléges/Institutions admitted to the privileges of the University and colleges and Institutions maintained by the University-Committee Report.

The Academic Council in its 53rd meeting held on 3rd and 4th June, 1996, has approved Ordinance 16 and Ordinance 17 on the Management of Colleges/Institutions admitted to the privileges of the University and colleges and Institutions maintained by the University respectively. The Ordinance which decided to refer the matter back to the Academic Council, after a Committee appointed by it had reviewed the Ordinance. The recommendations of the Committee at Annexure-'1' was placed before the Academic Council in its 54th meeting held on 21st and 22nd November, 1996. The Council considered the recommendations of the Committee appointed by the Executive Council and RESOLVED to accept the recommendations.

The matter is placed before the Executive Council for consideration.

The Committee has examined the Ordinances OB 16 and 17 and make the following observations.

(i) Regarding OB-16 since the interest of the University for the maintenance of the academic standards are taken care of by provisions of other Ordinances and the day to day administration is the responsibility of the sponsoring bodies,there is no need to have separate Ordinance.

Regarding OB-17,since the constitution of the Governing Body for the Constitution may come in the way of execution of some of the provisions of University Acts, statutes and Ordinances,the committee proposed to have an Advisory Committee instead of the Governing Body. The Constitution and the responsibilities of the advisory Committee are as proposed and is given seperately as OB-16.

Ordinance on Colleges and Institutions Maintained by the University under Section 26(O) of the NEHU Act.

1. There shall be an advisory Committee for a college or Institution Maintained by the University.
2. The responsibility of the advisory Committee shall be as follows:
  - (a) to advise on the programmes of teaching in the college and to determine the teaching requirements of the college.
  - (b) to propose new teaching posts in various departments and suggest expansion of the departments, if necessary.
  - (c) to regulate the admission of the students for the various courses of the college within the framework of the policy laid down by the University.
  - (d) to formulate guidelines for hostel accommodation and welfare of students.
  - (e) to formulate guidelines regarding discipline of students
  - (f) to proposed academic programmes such as seminars, conference extension work etc. for the specific requirements of the college.
  - (g) to lay down guidelines for purchase of library books and laboratory equipments in consultation with the appropriate departments.

The Advisory Committee will be constituted as follows:

- (1) The Vice-Chancellor or his nominee-Chairman
- (2) Two members to be nominated by the Executive Council from among the reputed educationists of the concerned state.
- (3) Four members of the teaching staff of the concerned college by rotation in order of seniority.
- (4) Director of Public Instruction/Director of Higher Education of the concerned state.
- (5) The Principal of the concerned college(Ex-officio Member Secretary)

Members, others than ex-officio members, shall hold office for a term of two years.

The quorum for the meeting of the Advisory Body shall be four.
