(1) There shall be a Selection Committee for making recommendations to the Executive Council for appointment to the posts of Professor, Reader, Lecturer, Registrar, Deputy Registrar, Assistant Registrar, Finance Officer, Controller of Examinations, Librarian, Deputy Librarian, Assistant Librarian, Director, Deputy Director, Assistant Director and such equivalent posts of University Science Instrumentation Centre / Computer Centre / Physical Education, Principal / Director and teachers of Colleges / Institutes maintained by the University.

1.(A) Notwithstanding anything contained in 20(1) above, there shall be a Selection Committee for making recommendations to the Executive Council for placement / promotion of teachers as Lecturer (Senior Scale), Lecturer (Selection Grade), Reader and Professor under the Career Advancement Scheme or any such other scheme introduced by the University Grants Commission and accepted by the University from time to time.

Statute 20(1)**Career Advancement**

(c) The Selection Committee for Career Advancement shall be the same as those for direct recruitment for each category, i.e., Professor, Reader, Lecturers respectively.

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1.(A) Notwithstanding anything contained in 20(1) above, there shall be a Selection Committee for making recommendations to the Executive Council for placement / promotion of teachers as Lecturer (Senior Scale), Lecturer (Selection Grade), Reader and Professor under the Career Advancement Scheme or any such other scheme introduced by the University Grants Commission and accepted by the University from time to time.

Statute 20(1)**Career Advancement**

(c) The Selection Committee for promotion under Career Advancement Scheme for Professor and Reader shall be the same as those for direct recruitment.

However, the Selection Committee for placement of Lecturer in the senior scale and selection grade under the Career Advancement Scheme and such other scheme as may be notified by the UGC / MHRD, from time to time shall be as per the Ordinances.

OE -5 (New Clause)

Incentives For M.Phil/ (B) (A) Two advance increments shall be admissible to those who enter the

Ph.D. those who enter the University system with an M.Phil / M.Litt. while four advanced increments to those with Ph.D. / D.Litt / D.Sc./ D.Phil. degree

Provided further that one increment shall be admissible to a teacher who acquires an M.Phil / M.Litt. degree, while two increments shall be admissible to a teacher who acquires a Ph.D./D.Litt. / D. Sc. in his / her service career. But the number of increments shall not exceed two if a teacher acquires both the degrees in his / her service career.

Ph.D. University system with an M.Phil / M.Litt. while four advanced increments to those with Ph.D. / D.Litt./ D.Sc./ D.Phil. degree

Provided that one increment shall be admissible to a teacher who acquires an M.Phil / M.Litt. degree, while two increments shall be admissible to a teacher who acquires a Ph.D. / D.Litt. / D. Sc. in his / her service career. But the number of increments shall not exceed two if a teacher acquires both the degrees in his / her service career.

Provided further that a Lecturer with Ph.D. will be eligible for two advance increments when she / he moves into Selection Grade / Reader.

Proposed Ordinance on Minimum Qualifications for Direct recruitment to the post of Librarian, Dy. Librarian and Assistant Librarian, Deputy Registrar and Assistant Registrar. Director of Physical Education / Deputy and Assistant DPEs.

(Under Section 26(1)(n))

Note:1. Notwithstanding anything contained in (i) to (vi) the 55% marks shall not be insisted upon for those already in University service.(2) a relaxation of 5% marks shall be applicable to SC/ST candidates at entry level. Provided that minimum marks in both cases shall not be less than 50%.

Proposed Ordinance on Minimum Qualifications for Direct recruitment to the post of Librarian, Dy. Librarian and Assistant Librarian, Deputy Registrar and Assistant Registrar. Director of Physical Education / Deputy and Assistant DPEs.

(Under Section 26(1)(n))

Note:1. Notwithstanding anything contained in (i) to (x) the 55% marks shall not be insisted upon for those already in University service.

(2) A relaxation of 5% marks shall be applicable to SC/ST candidates at entry level provided that minimum marks in both cases shall not be less than 50%.

New Ordinance on Selection Committee for placement of Lecturers in the Senior Scale and Selection Grade.

The following shall comprise the Selection Committee for the purpose of placement of Lecturers in the Senior Scale and Selection Grade.

- (i) Vice-Chancellor Chairman
- (ii) Dean of the School concerned/
Principal of the College
- (iii) Head of the Department concerned
- (iv) Not more than 3(three) Professors
of the Department/School concerned.

The candidates to be considered for placement in the Senior Scale and Selection Grade shall submit a performance appraisal in the format to be prescribed.

- (ii) Drafting of a Regulation for procedure of examinations, fee structure, attendance and equivalent on Certificate and PG Diploma Courses.

EC:107:2000:5:1:(ii): The Council considered the procedure of examinations, fee structure attendance and re-evaluation with regard to Certificate and PG Diploma Courses and RESOLVED that the same will apply as for the Post Graduate Courses.

- (iii) Amendment to admission criteria for M.Sc. Bio-Chemistry.

EC:107:2000:5:1:(iii): The Council considered the amendment to the admission criteria for M.Sc. in Bio-Chemistry and RESOLVED that Honours in Bio-Chemistry and Bio-Technology may be given preference over others but should not be the requisite criteria. The Council, further noted with regret that the eligibility criteria as proposed by the Department was notified without the approval of the Executive Council.

- (iv) Revised Ordinance OB-6 and Regulation RB-1-6 relating to affiliation of Colleges.

EC:107:2000:5:1:(iv): The Council considered the revised Ordinance OB-6 and Regulation RB-16 relating to affiliation of Colleges and RESOLVED to approve the same as per Annexure 'A'. The Council, further RESOLVED that the University may take up with the respective State Governments the creation of the minimum number of posts of Lecturers for the Colleges to conform with the norms laid down by the University
