- (it) Procedures for Admission of Overseas students and fees thereto.

As per Clause 12 of Regulation RC-1 on the admission to Post Graduate Departments which reads thus-

“For the purpose of admission in respect of overseas students, such students may be accommodated against supernumerary vacancies provided the Department concerned has adequate facilities and admission is made through a Central Committee appointed for the purpose.”

The Central Committee had been duly notified in pursuance of Academic Council Resolution No:AC:56:97:5:1:(v) and Executive Council Resolution No:EC:95:97:5:8:(v) and the Central Committee has met and framed the procedure for admission as well as the fees to be charged to overseas students which may be seen at Annexure - A.

The Committee's recommendations is placed before the Council for consideration.

Central Committee for Admission of Overseas Students

Procedure for Admission

1. The admission to the foreign students will be given against the supernumerary seats and will not exceed 20 percent of the total number of seats sanctioned for the Department concerned.
2. Admission will be given in order of merit.
3. Admission to the Post Graduate Programme will be in July and M.Phil and Ph.D. once in every semester.
4. All the applications received by the Department concerned will be sent to the Convener, Central Committee after the detail scrutiny for consideration and necessary approval. The Department will also forward its clear recommendation and supporting documents alongwith the application.
5. The students seeking admission into the study programme should possess valid student/research visa issued by the Indian Embassy located in their respective countries. No request for admission will be entertained from the students who do not possess valid travel documents. No admission will be considered on 'Tourist Visa'.
6. The students will also be governed by the instructions that may be received from the Government of India from time to time on the issue of admission or on pursuing of studies by foreign students.
7. The academic fee structure for the foreign students shall be the following :

A consolidated amount per annum payable in two equal instalments will be charged according to the rates mentioned below :

The amount includes actual tuition, examination and other non-refundable compulsory fees.
