- (1) Request for granting EOL to Prof.  
(Mrs) S.Miri, Deptt. of Philosophy

Prof (Mrs) S.Miri has submitted an application stating that she had been awarded Fellowship to work on a research project on the North-East for a year by the Indian Institute of Advanced Studies, Shimla, and the letter of award is placed at Annexure - I. She has stated that the Fellowship will start on June 15, 1998 and has requested to grant her EOL for a period of one year.

Prof (Mrs) S.Miri has resumed duties in the Department with effect from 1.12.97 after the expiry of the previous spell of 3yrs E.O.L granted to her i.e with effect from 1.12.94 to 30.11.96 and extended from 1.12.96 to 30.11.97 to undertake Research Work under a Fellowship awarded to her by the Indian Council of Philosophical Research granted in terms of Clause 8(iii) (a) of Ordinance OE-6 approved by the Executive Council at its 84th meeting held on 8.12.94 and 92nd meeting held on 21.3.97. The above application of Research work under a Fellowship awarded to her by the ICPR was routed through proper channel and forwarded by the University.

Prof (Mrs) S.Miri vide her application dated 12.5.98 then requesting for grant of E.O.L for another period of one year starting from June 15, 1998 as she has been invited by the Indian Institute of Advanced Studies for the award of a Fellowship for one year. Under OE-6 Cl.8(iii) EOL cannot be granted until after expiry of 5 (five) years return from the previous spell of EOL or three yrs after Study or Sabbatical leave.

Since Prof (Mrs) S.Miri has just resumed duties on ~~only~~ expiry of three years EOL and has completed ~~six~~ months service in the Department, she therefore does not fulfill the requirement of granting the second EOL under the Ordinance. Secondly, Prof (Mrs) S. Miri is covered under CPF Scheme and in terms of OE-6 Cl.8(iii) (d) she is required to pay the employees share of the CPF either by herself or the foreign employer for counting the ~~past~~ CPF/Gratuity benefits during the period of the three years EOL w.e.f 1.12.94 to 31.11.97 spent at I.C.P.R.

The Head of Department while forwarding the application of Prof (Mrs) S.Miri has put a remark that Prof (Mrs) S.Miri may be granted leave and ~~substitute~~ ~~be provided~~ ~~against~~ leave vacancy. ~~the~~

Madam,

This related to the award of Fellowship in this institute.

2. We have great pleasure in informing you that the Chairman, Governing Body of the Institute has approved the award of a Fellowship to you for a period of one year to enable you to pursue the research project on Autonomy of the Tribal Form of Life. The period of Fellowship could be extended for upto one year more, if deemed necessary subject, however, to prior approval of the Governing Body.

3. During the term of your fellowship at the Institute, you will be given a Fellowship Grant equivalent to your basic pay being drawn by you at present plus allowances as are admissible to Central Government employees stationed at Shimla and a free hard-furnished accommodation for your stay in Shimla. The hard-furnished accommodation will include 4 chairs, 3 tables, one dining table, with four chairs, one canopy Almirah, 2 beds, one dressing table, 2 book racks and one wardrobe only. You are advised to bring your lines articles etc.

4. You are requested to bring with you (or send by mail) your last pay certificate from your parent organisation indicating clearly the date of relief, pay scale, break-up of emoluments drawn, regular deductions on account of provident fund etc., date of next increment and also a certificate that you have been granted Extra-Ordinary leave (without pay) by your institution to take-up the Fellowship. Please note that a Fellow of the Institute must draw his Fellowship Grant from the Institute and cannot be in the payroll of any other organization during the tenure of his/her Fellowship.

5. For joining the Fellowship at this Institute, you will be paid travel expenses as per Govt. norms. The same norm will apply when you leave the Institute at the end of your term.

6. You are requested to complete your research project within the duration of your Fellowship and submit a monograph to the Institute before the period of Fellowship is over. The Institute shall have the first right on its publication as we are keen that the findings of your research are made accessible to the wider world of scholarship.

7. As a Fellow, you will be expected to prepare your manuscript for submission to the Institute on the computer available in the Institute. If, for some avoidable reasons you might have to take outside help for preparation of the manuscript for submission, prior approval, giving the details of the work and estimated expenditure, will be necessary and the charges on this account will be considered for re-imbusement as per the Institute rules.

8. You are also informed that any Fellow who leaves his or her Fellowship prematurely without approval of the Governing Body or who does not submit the end-product of his or her research to the Institute will not subsequently be associated with the academic programmes.

9. The Institute has a well equipped library. You are, however advised to bring such special books in your respective field of research as you might possess when coming to the Institute. Suggestions for acquiring books needed for your work will be most welcome. A list of such books giving full particulars i.e title, author, publisher, date of publication etc. may be sent to the Librarian of the Institute and every endeavour will be made to procure them for you.

10. The Institute is residential in character. Besides working for your research project you will be expected to participate in discussions, seminars, symposia and workshops organised by the Institute from time to time.

11. A copy of the Notes for the Guidance of Fellows which will give an idea of the aims and objectives of the Institute and the facilities that are available is enclosed for your information.

12. May I request to kindly communicate your acceptance of the award of Fellowship offered by the Institute within a fortnight from the date of receipt of this letter.

13. You are requested to join the Institute preferably by 15th June 1998.
