

5:6 ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW DEPARTMENT/CENTRE/COURSES

1) Starting of Management Course

In last A C a coregroup was set up to start the Management Course. The representatives of the coregroup were deputed to UGC and AICTE. The representatives most various Officials of UGC & AICTE and gathered that the MBA Course which was Offered to NEHU is 1985 could be revived. The UGC desired to know the extent to which self sufficiency could be achieve by the course or by some programmes.

On 3rd June, 1999 a meeting of Market Leaders in Government, Business, Public & Public Cororations were held. The participants from Government, Business, Coroporations (NABARD, NEEPCO, SIDBI) and Association (SMA) management examined the report of Environment assessment and market for MBA graduates.

In view of the opinion expressed by the participants at the market assessment meeting to have an institute structure for MBA. The following proposal is placed for approval.

1. That the departmental and school structure are unsuitable for MBA course because they allow little scope for external participation and flexibility, necessary for the success of the courses. Further it requires different cost structures for different fees structures from different classes of students. The guest facilities are to diffirent levels and status and have to be brought to the department for interaction,. They have also to be paid remuneration or honorarium which will be different from other conventional courses.

2. That the institute shall operate within the University framework, governed by an Advisory Committee Cum Governing Body, where all participants, constituents and collaborators including representatives of AC& EC may be members.

3. That the features and operational modalities be incorporated into an ordinance which is being placed before the house for consideration.

The matter was placed before the 61st meeting of the Academic Council and the council and the Council considered starting of the Department of Business Management and while resolving to approve the same in Principle desired that the Chairman of the Council and the core-group ^{appointed for} the purpose may take necessary action so that the Department can take off with effect from the academic session 2000 to 2001.
