On 13.12.96, a letter dated 10.12.96 from Director CIEFL Regional Centre, Shillong have been received and placed as Annexure 'A' for perusal by the Council, where in the CIEFL had indicated certain conditions from its end.

In view of this letter, the Council is requested to make a decision before office can send a reply to the concerned Director.

Madam,

I tried to meet you on Saturday, December 7th, in connection with the construction of our permanent campus on your land. Since you were not available I met Mr. Sailo and arranged to meet him again on Monday, the 9th. As there was no power supply on Monday, I could not copy and send the documents you needed. I now enclose the documents for your kind reference. As we have been repeatedly pointing out, no architect worth his salt would prepare conceptual drawings and blue prints of buildings without seeling the site. This was explained to your Technical Consultant on October, 26, 1995, and he agreed with me that the first step to be taken was to demarcate the plot.

The funding for construction has been held up, despite the intervention of the Governor, H.E. Shri M.M.Jacob, and the HRD Minister, Shri S.R.Bomma, because we have yet to have a formal commitment from you regarding the plot.

It has also been explained to your office that being partly under the HRD/Ministry our construction work has to be done by the CPWD as deposit work. Therefore I request you to expedite the process of demarcation of the land and also send me a formal letter with the necessary assurance that the land would be given to us. As my Vice-Chancellor wrote to your Vice-Chancellor on 28th June, 1994(95) we need a formal agreement or a deed of gift. It goes without saying that the CPWD would work in consultation with your University Architect in drawing up the plans and designs. If necessary, you may stipulate such conditions as you deem reasonable and fit. This may be treated as urgent.
