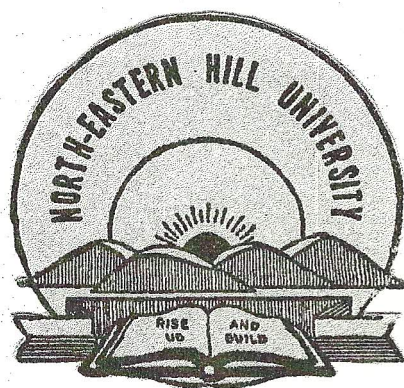

(i) Amendment/Clarification on
NEHU Ordinance OB-6.

A Committee was constituted vide resolution No:AC:74:2005:5:7:(ii) under the Chairmanship of Prof. K.Ismail, to look into the Amendment/Clarification of NEHU, Ordinance OB-6.

The Committee met on 19.5.2006, 10.10.2006 and 16.11.2006, the minutes of the Committee, proposed amendment & minutes of the 76th meeting of the Academic Council held on 20.11.06 are placed at Annexure 'A', 'B' and 'C' respectively.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.

Minutes of the meetings of the Committee constituted to look into the Amendment/Clarification on NEHU Ordinance OB-6

The committee first met on May 19, 2006 and identified the difficulties faced during the processes of inspection and affiliation of colleges. The lack of clarity in some of the clauses of the Ordinance OB-6 was also identified. The committee carefully examined each clause of the Ordinance and drafted various modifications.


The committee met again on October 10, 2006 and continued examining the Ordinance and proposing modifications. The committee authorized Prof. K. Ismail and Prof. Nikhilesh Kumar to work out further details.

Prof. K. Ismail and Prof. Nikhilesh Kumar after a number of sittings brought out the details for consideration of the committee.

The committee met once again on November 16, 2006 and decided to recommend to the Academic Council the draft amendments to the Ordinance OB-6 for its consideration and approval. The committee further decided to make the following recommendations:

- (i) In the modified Ordinance OB-6 the matters related to permanent affiliation are incorporated in the Ordinance itself by shifting them from Regulation RB-7. Therefore, the Regulation RB-7 on Permanent Affiliation be dispensed with.
- (ii) The particulars regarding fees are proposed to be shifted from the existing Ordinance as Regulation under the title, "Regulation on Affiliation and Other Related Fees". It is proposed that these matters related to fees be put as Regulation RB-7. Such a step would facilitate the working of the Ordinance OB-6 as any future revisions in such matters related to fees could easily be incorporated in the Regulation without amending the Ordinance itself.
- (iii) The various prescribed proforma that are referred in the Ordinance require corresponding modifications. This committee may be authorized to bring in necessary modifications in the existing proforma and introduce new proforma, if necessary, and to submit it to the Chairman, Academic Council.

General Comments: (i) Shillong Law College (SLC) was established in 1964 and has been in existence for the past 42 years and was initially affiliated to Gauhati University. After establishment of NEHU in 1973, the college has been affiliated (provisionally) from time to time, but continuously for over 30 years now. As per NEHU Affiliating Rules, the College is eligible to seek permanent affiliation. (ii) The SLC has its own (owned) premises in the heart of the city measuring 4008 Sq.ft., with no hostel facility (non-residential). They have adequate classrooms and buildings for current operations and have plans of new constructions from their own funds (detail in proforma). (iii) The college has funds to the tune of Rs.1,11,1,279.32 as on 7.7.06 (Cash Book) as verified. (iv) It has annual revenues to the tune of Rs. 30.00 lakhs from investment and current revenues like fees etc. and the annual expenditure as reflected in audited accounts are to the tune of Rs.22-23 lakhs, i.e. the college is surplus as of now. The financial management of the college has been prudent and though entirely self financed, it has never faced financial problems. (v) The regular teachers (the principal and three teachers) get UGC pay scales with allowances and House rent subsidies. (vi) One teacher has submitted his Ph.D. apart from thr principal who has a doctoral Degree as required. The other two teachers need to obtain NET qualifications or required research degrees, and this needs to be emphasized. The college may have to appoint one more regular teacher as per the Bar Council rules and conditions. (vii) The College has its constitution and set of rules governing services of teachers and employees. (viii) The Library has 6529 volumes and collection of All India Reporter from 1924 – which is adequate. The library has qualified technical staff (Librarian) and is in the process of computerization. The college library now has 4 computers for student use with internet facility. (ix) As reflected in the annual results, there has been a fair degree of improvements over the last few years. (x) There have been complaints about some irregularities in teaching and other non-compliances by the teachers, which the Governing body of the college needs to look into. (xi) Over all, in my opinion (since other members of the committee did not participate), the College is eligible for permanent Affiliation, subject to a review of the situation after two years of extending the affiliation, if at all.</p>	<p>The Affiliation Committee resolved that since the inspection was done by one person only, Dr.J.J. 		<p>ERD Foundation (A registered Trust under the Societies Registration Act of 1860) has applied to NEHU for permission to open a new college named Regional College of Higher Education for BBA, BCA, B.Sc (Bio-tech) and B.Sc.(Bio-chem) courses. It plans to start the new college in a rented building in Dispur, Guwahati, which also houses Central IT College run by the ERD Foundation and offering correspondence courses under Manipal Sikkim University. ERD Foundation proposes to use some of the space presently occupied by the Central IT College and additional floor area under construction in the same building as well as in an adjacent building.</p> <p>The Committee visited the premises of the proposed college from 10.30 A.M. to 2.30 P.M. on June 15, 2006 to assess the feasibility of starting the new College. It held extensive discussions with the president of the Trust (Mr.Mahbubul Hoque), some member trustees, several teachers of the Central IT College (those that are likely to be appointed in the new college), and students of the Central IT College. The Committee inspected the classrooms, Laboratories, and Library presently being used by the Central IT College for running the Sikkim Manipal University Correspondence courses, and examined the progress of the construction of an additional carpet area of approximately 9500 square feet.</p> <p>The key point that emerged is that substantial investment is needed from the ERD Foundation to bring the class rooms, Laboratories and Library to NEHU requirements for starting a new college, running four courses with the projected enrolment for the first year of 100 students in BBA, 100 in BCA, 30 in BSc (Bio-Tech) and 30 in B. Sc (Bio-Chem).
