

(vi) CREATION OF A POST OF CHIEF MEDICAL OFFICER IN NERU

The U.C. vide their letter No.F.13-2/86 (NP-I) dated 22.4.88 forwarded to this University copies of Govt. of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare letters on various facilities relating to the medical post for implementing the same in this University. This may kindly be seen at annexure 'A'.

As per one of such letter No.11014/46/07 -CHS-II dated 20.8.87 it has been decided that M.O. (2200-4000) may be promoted to the grade of Senior Medical Officer (3000-4500) after 5 years of regular service as M.O. on the basis of Seniority-Cum-Fitness. Vacancies are to be worked out on the basis of the combine strength of Sr. Medical Officer, Medical and total number of Officer in position in both grade put together. The combine strength of M.O. and S.M.O. shall remain unaltered and the post will be interchangeable. The above decision have been approved by the cabinet.

This University vide Executive Council resolution No.73:91:6:02:(III) has also implemented the same by promoting MO (2200-4000) to S.M.O. (3000-4500).

The G.O.I. vide their letter No.32012/1/88-CHS-II dated 14.3.88 promoted some of the SMO (3000-4500) of CHS to the post of CMO (3700-5000) of CHS. A relevant question therefore arises whether this University can promote a SMO to the post of CMO in the scale of Rs. (3700-5000).

The case has been placed on the 89th B.C. held on 8.3.96 to allow:-

- (i) M.O. on completion of 4 years regular service may be promoted to SMO grade-II in the pay scale of Rs. 3000-4500/-.
- (ii) SMO Grade-II on completion of 12 years of service out of which at least 5 years as SMO Grade-II may be promoted to SMO Grade-I in the scale of pay of Rs.3700-5000/-.
- (iii) 25% of the post of MO may be converted into the post of CMO in the scale of pay of Rs.4500-5700/- and Sr.M.O. Grade-I may be promoted as CMO provided he has completed at least 18 years of service as MO out of which at least 5 years should be as SMO Grade-I.

For the purpose of (i), (ii), (iii) above promotion will be made by upgrading the post and making personal to the incumbent.

However the above proposal has not been agreed to by said EC and it resolved that the time bound promotion package formulated by the ministry of Health and Family Welfare may be obtained and till then the matter may be kept pending. The TIKKU Report has been announced but it has not yet been implemented.

The University vide DU letter No.F.7-9/Estt.II/87 (Vol.II)-6/ dated 16.8.96 has written to the Secretary, UGC on the implementing of TIKKU Committee report duly submitted to the ministry, but the Secretary vide his letter No.13-2/86 (CU) dated 10.9.96 addressed to the ministry with a copy to this University has sought the clarification whether the recommendation of the TIKKU Committee on service doctor are applicable to the Central University like NERU, but till date no reply has been received either from UGC or from the ministry inspite of several reminders.

In view of the said GOI letter mentioned at para 4 above, it may be seen that promotion to the post of Chief Medical Officer(CMO) (3700-5000) can take place only when a post of CMO is created and sanctioned. The CMO's post in the scale of Rs.3700-5000 being a class-I post cannot be created without prior sanction and approval of the UGC.

It is therefore proposed that EC may please consider the feasibility of recommending to UGC for creation a post CMO in the scale of Rs. 3700-5000/-. The question of filling up the post may be as per the term and condition specified at (III) of prepage.

The matter is put up to Executive Council for its consideration.

- (iii) Recommendation of the Selection Committee held on 30.5.96 & approval of the Executive Council at its 90th meeting.

No: EC: 92: 97: 6: 2: (iii): The Council considered the appointment of Ms. R. Roy as Lecturer in English at Mizoram Campus and RESOLVED that a final offer of appointment may be issued to her under a Registered A/D cover and she may be allowed to reply/join latest by 15th of April, 1997 failing which the offer may be given to the next candidate in the list. The Council, further RESOLVED that the validity of the Selection Committee's recommendations may be extended by a period of six months.

- (iv) Appointment of Prof. B. Pakem as V.C., NEHU, for a term of 5 (five) years.

No: EC: 92: 97: 6: 2: (iv): The Council noted the reappointment of Prof. B. Pakem for a second term as the Vice-Chancellor with effect from 18.1.97 and RESOLVED that he may be allowed to retain his lien in the Department of Political Science upto the date of his superannuation, that is, 31.12.97.

- (v) Appointment of Pro-Vice-Chancellors, NEHU.

No: EC: 92: 97: 6: 2: (v): The Council considered the appointment of Prof. R. Lalthantluanga and Prof. M. S. Sangma as Pro-Vice-Chancellors for Mizoram and Tura Campuses respectively and while approving the same RESOLVED that the term of office of Prof. M. S. Sangma shall be upto 31.12.2000 only.

- (vi) Creation of a post of Chief Medical Officer in NEHU.

No: EC: 92: 97: 6: 2: (vi): The Council considered the upgradation of pay-scale in respect of the Medical Officers/Senior Medical Officers of the University and RESOLVED that the Senior Medical Officers in the pay-scale of Rs. 3000-4500/- may be upgraded to Senior Medical Officer Grade I in the scale of Rs. 3700-5000/- on completion of 12 years of service out of which atleast 5 years must be as Senior Medical Officer Grade II in the scale of Rs. 3000-4500. The Council, further RESOLVED that as regards the conversion of posts to that of Chief Medical Officer the same may be done on a specific approval from the University Grants Commission.
