

Item No. (x) Resignation of Shri.C.Lalramzauva
from the post of Lecturer.

Shri,C.Lalramzauva joined the PU College as Research Associate in the Department of English with effect from 2-4-84 and subsequently redesignated as Lecturer on 1/1/86. Half pay leave for 109 days was granted to him with effect from 1/4/91 - 18/7/91 by the Principal Pachhunga University College on personal ground. His request for Extra ordinary leave for 2 years with effect from 19/7/91 for practising law was regretted as there is no provision in the Ordinance for such purposes and was advised to resign from the post in case he wishes to continue practise law. The matter was reported in the 94th Executive Council and in its resolution NO:94:97:6:2:(viii) (anexure 1) resolved not to accept his resignation on account of his unauthorised absense and directed him to explain why action should not be taken against his unauthorised absence. Show cause notice was served on him on 7/4/98 and explanation received was taken up in the Executive Council meeting. The said Executive Council resolution NO:97:98:6:2:(xxvii)(anexure II) resolved that the process of his termination be initiated. But Executive Council's decision is however silent on the effective date of his termination as to whether it would be effective from the dt. of expiry of the half pay leave granted to him on 18/7/91 or from the date he was granted half pay leave for 109 days with effect from 1-4-91. Under clause 8 (ii) of NEHU Ordinance O E 6 States that in case of failure to return to duty at the end of period of leave sanctioned to him, the service of a teacher shall be liable to be terminated from the date of commencement of the period of leave so granted to him and shall have to refund to the University the pay and allowances if any received by him (including other kinds of leave taken in addition) sanctioned to him for the purpose.

In view of the above clause the matter is put up to the Executive Council for a decision on the effective date of his termination.
