Sub: Plea for sympathetic reconsideration for failed 2000 Degree (Part I) candidates.

Sir,

The K.S.U. wishes to draw your attention to the following legitimate demand, with a request to kindly have this genuine and justified demand addressed on an urgent basis.

That Sir, in the present Degree examination procedure, students are not allowed to do his/her Part II until all papers are cleared in Part I. This creates tremendous frustration among the present affected students as a number of students who have successfully got through in almost all but few papers will, lose one precious year, most of whom may turn out as dropouts.

Considering the overall interest of those unfortunate students, our proposal is - allow a student to do his/her Part II with 3 papers failed in Part I exam for Arts and Commerce i.e. 3 back papers for Arts and Commerce and with 5 papers failed in Part I exams for Science i.e. 5 back papers for Science.

With earnest hope that this representation will be considered favourably by you and the Academic Council members of the NEHU, I, on behalf of the K.S.U. would like to appreciate you on consideration of the matter.

Subject: Suggestions on the need to review the present examination system.

Sir,

On behalf of the Education Cell of the F.K.J.G.P., I have the honour to present to you the following suggestions of our Organisation in regards to our view that the present examination system of Part-I and Part-II be immediately reviewed in the best interest of the students and their smooth academic pursuits.

1. That according to our findings, many of the students and parents have voiced their unhappiness and complaint over the difficulty caused by the present Part-I and Part-II examination system which according to them is more complicated unlike the previous examination system.
2. That the present examination system be changed and in its stead a better system of Annual System of Examination (1 + 1 + 1) with no arrear subject facility be introduced and implemented.
3. That in the case of those students who failed in the 2000 Examination of which results have been declared recently, a special consideration be granted to allow those who failed in just two subjects to sit for another examination of Part-II in the form of carrying over the failed subjects at the Part-II examination.

Therefore, in the light of the above issues and suggestions, we would humbly request you to kindly give your consideration to these proposals put forward by us which we believe are vital for the interest of our students and their success.
