

(ii) Affiliation of various Colleges - Inspection Reports.

The various recommendation of the Affiliation Committee (Appendix-I) and the Inspection reports regarding affiliation of various Colleges were placed before the Academic Council in its 56th meeting held on 21st & 22nd Nov. 1997 for consideration.

The Academic Council after considering the same resolved as under :-

St. Edmund's College: The college should not start the course on Bio-Chemistry without the prior appointment of teachers.

Govt. Aizawl College: The college may start the course on Office Management and Secretarial Practice subject to fulfilment of the requirements laid down by the Inspection Team.

Singh Memorial College: Provisional affiliation for B.A. may be extended for a period of three years.

Shillong Law College: Provisional affiliation may be extended for a period of ONE year only for 1997-98 and provisional affiliation for the previous years be regularised.

Champhai College: Provisional affiliation be granted for a period of three years for Honours in English, Mizo (Elective) and Economics Pass

Govt. Aizawl College: The college may start the course on Office Management and Secretarial Practice subject to fulfilment of the requirements laid down by the Inspection Team.

Singh Memorial College: Provisional affiliation for B.A. may be extended for a period of three years.

Shillong Law College: Provisional affiliation may be extended for a period of ONE year only for 1997-98 and provisional affiliation for the previous years be regularised.

iii) Inspection Reports of various Colleges.

The Affiliation Committee met on 23.6.97 and decided on the Inspection Report of the following colleges as given below:

1. Inspection Reports of the Colleges:

a) St. Edmund's College, Shillong:

The Committee considered the Inspection Reports of St. Edmund's College for Bio-Chemistry and resolved that the College should not start the course without prior appointment of teachers as recommended. The case is approved as per Inspection Report.

b) Govt. Aizawl College, Aizawl:

The Committee considered the Inspection Report of Govt. Aizawl College for vocational course on Office Management and Secretarial Practices. The Committee felt that since the course has not yet been gone through BUGS, the CDC should write to the Principal informing the college as per the recommendation of the Inspection Report. They should start the course only from 1998-99 and fulfill all the conditions laid down in the Inspection Report before starting the course. The college also may be asked to submit the syllabus and course to be placed in the BUGS in Commerce/Academic Council.

d) Umshyrpi College, Shillong.

RECOMMENDATIONS :

The observations of the inspection team are as follows :

1. The course has been sponsored by the UGC.
2. An amount of Rs.2.33 lakhs has been already released to the college (by UGC)
3. The UGC has recommended that the amount released to the College may be spent to run the course, as soon as the affiliation is granted (for the course) by the University.
4. The college has enough space for running the course.
5. The college Principal has proposed that the services of the existing teaching in Commerce and Economics departments will be utilised to run the course with the help of some guest lecturers.
6. In view of the above, the inspection committee/team recommends provisional affiliation from 1998-99 session under the following conditions :

- A. The College will procure necessary books as per the list of suggested books in the syllabi before the commencement of the course.
- B. Equipments/necessary infrastructure for teaching and laboratory work for the course will be procured before starting the course.
- C. The college will recruit qualified teachers to teach the course/send the existing teachers for necessary training to qualify for the teaching of the course.
- D. The syllabus of the course submitted by the college to the University may be modified to conform to the existing University structure before commencement of the course.

The Director, College Development Council and the Principal of Shillong Law College informed the Committee that the Bar Council of India proposes to visit the college with the view to considering extension of professional accreditation to the college.
