**NO:AC:83:2010:7:6:(ii):** The Council considered the recommendation of the Plan Working Group relating to UGC approved specific grants amounting to Rs.40.00 crores under XIth Plan for development of Tura Campus and Rs.8.00 crores for development of the Department of Management, Tura Campus. The Committee therefore recommended to open four more new Departments, namely, Department of Computer Applications, Department of Agri Business Management and Food Technology, Department of Horticulture and Department of History and Archeology, additional teaching and non-teaching posts for the new departments as well as the existing Departments in Tura Campus and other necessary requirements. **(iii) Appointment of Prof.A.S.Chandel under Statute 21**

Under UPE (University with Potential for Excellence) Scheme, the University, among others, initiated the process of Library digitization. In order to oversee the completion of work of library digitization, Prof.A.S.Chandel was appointed as Visiting Fellow in the Department of Library and Information Science initially for a period of one year with effect from 25.05.2009 against the vacant post of a Professor in the said Department. Although Prof.Chandel, was appointed specifically for library digitization, he has also extended his services in the matter of teaching and research in the Department of Library and Information Science. The appointment of Dr.Chandel was made in accordance with the provision laid down under Regulation RE- 2.

On completion of the first term and on the recommendation of the Implementation Committee on Library Digitization, the appointment of Prof.Chandel was further extended by another one year against the vacant post of a Professor in the Department of Library and Information Science under RE- 2. The second term of appointment of Prof.Chandel expired on 29.07.2011.

Meanwhile, the Implementation Committee on Library Digitization recommended that the services of Prof.Chandel may be extended further till March 2012 (since the UPE Scheme is valid upto 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2012) so as to enable him to train the persons who shall be associated with the library digitization programme in future.

It may be mentioned that the appointment under Regulation RE 2 can be made for a maximum period of 2 years. On the other hand the Executive Council in its 144<sup>th</sup> meeting resolved that the Regulation RE-2 be kept in abeyance since there are no posts/budget created for the purpose. In view of this, the services of Prof.A.S.Chandel could not be extended under RE- 2. However, in the interest of the University Prof.Chandel has been appointed as Visiting Fellow under the merged Scheme for a period of 3 months with effect from 30.07.2011 to 29.10.2011. A copy of the order is appended vide **Annexure 'A'**.

Now, in order to consider continuation of service of Prof.Chandel beyond 29.10.2011 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2012, it is proposed that Prof.Chandel may be appointed as Professor in the Department of Library and Information Science under Statute 21 (1). The provision laid down under Statute 21 (1) is re-produced below :-

"Notwithstanding anything contained in Statute 20, the EC may invite a person of high academic distinction and professional attainments to accept a post of Professor or Reader or any other academic post in the University, as the case may be, on such terms and conditions as it deems fit, and on the person agreeing to do so, appoint him to the post."

The Biodata of Prof.Chandel is appended below vide **annexure 'B'**.

In consideration of the said provision, Prof.Chandel may be appointed on the following terms and conditions :

- i) He shall be paid a regular scale of pay of Professor i.e in the pay band of Rs.37,400/- – 67,000/- with grade pay of Rs.10,000/-.
- ii) His pay will be fixed as per pay fixation rules applicable for re-employed pensioner.
- iii) During the employment in the University Prof.Chandel be provided accommodation in RUAB Quarters of the University.



(v) Headship in the Centre of Science Education

I. Prof. Man Mohan Singh , Head, CSE has written to the Registrar, NEHU vide his letter No.CSE/2011/MMS/VC EC/0603.047 dated 3.6.2011(Annexure A) and to the Dean, School of Education vide letter No.CSE/2011/MMS/Dean PVC/0603.048 dated 3.6.2011 (Annexure B) informing that he would relieve himself from the duty of Head, CSE due to which he would not be able to act or discharge duties as Head of CSE on the allegations reproduced below:-

“On resuming duty of the Head, CSE on 6.4.2009 in view of the J &O of the High Court in anticipation of transfer of charge I had been continuously reminding the University to transfer the charge of the Centre after due process of audit and inventory verification (Assets: movable and immovable) as per GFR 190, 195 and 196 and held up imprest account and bills as per GFR 84.

The University has completely ignored the process of transfer the charge in total disregard to the said order for reappointment dejure dated 12.9.2008. Thereby disable me to discharge the duties as Head of the Centre.

Ipsa facto continue denial of transfer of charge over past two years and two months is deemed to be clear denial of re-appointment dejure.”

II. However the facts on record show that :- In compliance with the Order dated 12.11.2008 of the Hon'ble Guwahati High Court in W.P.C. 157(SH)2005 (Annexure C) and in pursuance of Resolution adopted by the Executive Council in its 136<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 25.3.2009, Prof. M.M. Singh was appointed as Head, Centre for Science Education vide Order No.F.5-5/Estt.II/Sc.Edn/2004-05-1070(Regr) dated 30.3.2009 (Annexure D). The then Head, CSE, Dr. D.

Bhattacharjee attempted to handover charge of the office of the Head, CSE to Prof. M.M. Singh, but Prof. Singh refused to take over the charge for reasons best known to him. As a result, Dr. Bhattacharjee was compelled to hand over the files, documents, keys etc. concerning the Centre to the then Registrar on 31.3.2009 (Annexure E).

III. It was only on 6.4.2009 that Prof. Singh assumed or rather assumed charge as Head, CSE without complying with the administrative requirement, namely submission of charge report. Prof. Singh also insisted that transferring of all assets, liabilities and records will be taken over by him only after completion of assessment and verification of stock. (Annexure F)

IV. Accordingly, on 12<sup>th</sup> May, 2009, Prof. D.R. Syiemlieh, the then Registrar, NEHU informed Prof. Singh that inventory of all files, assets and other materials kept in the office room of the Head of Centre of Science Education would be made in his presence and in the presence of Dr. D. Bhattacharjee and the office staff of the Centre for Science Education by the Proctor on 14<sup>th</sup> May, 2009 at 11.00 A.M. Prof. M.M. Singh did not attend the exercise. (Annexure G).

V. Despite sincere efforts made by the University to facilitate his functioning as Head of the Centre for Science Education by providing logistic support he refused to co-operate. As a last resort, Prof. D.R. Syiemlieh informed Prof. Singh on 6<sup>th</sup> July, 2009 (Annexure H) that the office room of the Head of the Centre for Science Education would be handed over to him for his official use on 9<sup>th</sup> July, 2009 at 10.30 A.M. by Prof D. Bhattacharjee of Centre for Science Education in the presence of the Proctor, NEHU, Section Officer, Estate Section, NEHU.

VI. Thus after a lapse of more than three months Prof. Singh officially took over the office room of the Head of the Centre for Science Education. The delay was due entirely to Prof. Singh's reluctance to co-operate.

VII. In pursuance of letter No.2-15/Estt.II/Regr/08-1142 dated 12<sup>th</sup> May, 2009(Annuxure I), attempts were made on several occasion to hand over the relevant files and keys of the almirahs pertaining to the Centre to him, but on some pretext or another he refused to received the files and keys. The latest attempt of the University to inventorize the materials lying in the CSE took place on 20.4.2011 for which the Asstt. Registrar (Estate) and other staff were deputed. Unfortunately Prof. M.M. Singh did not deem it necessary to attend. Instead, he deputed only the office cleaner to represent him vide letter No.CSE/2011/Head/REG Res AR Est/0420 025 dated 20.4.2011 (Annexure J) due to which the scientific equipments which were lying intact in the Demonstration Room could not be named/identified in Prof. Singh's absence (Annexure K).

VIII. As a result of the above, the Centre for Science Education has not functioned at all under him as the Head. It is on record that he has not submitted materials in respect of the Centre for inclusion in the Annual Report of the University for the year 2009-2010 and 2010-2011.

IX. It is clear from the foregoing paragraphs that every effort had been made by the University to enable Prof. Singh to function as Head of the Centre, but he has refused to co-operate. However, the most **conclusive proof** that the non-functioning of CSE is due to Prof. Man Mohan Singh's faulty and not the University's, may be seen from the Hon'ble Guwahati High Court's observation at Para 10 of its Order dated 20.7.2010 in C.O.P No. 30(SH)2009 where the Hon'ble High Court had concluded as follows:-

**“It is also seen that the Petitioner himself had a role in belated handing over of the files, papers as well as the keys of the Science Centre and under such circumstances, I am not inclined to accept the contention made by the Petitioner that even after appointment of the Petitioner as the Head, the papers, documents and keys were willfully withheld to disable him to function as a full fledged Head of the Science Centre.”**

XI. It may also be mentioned that in his letter No.CSE/2011/MMS/DEAN PVC/0603.048 dated 3.6.2011(Annexure L) addressed to the Dean, School of Education, Prof. Singh alleged that the University did not provide him with the list of bonafide records of other faculty duly appointed. However, all the orders pertaining to transfer, posting and appointment of all faculty members under CSE have been duly marked to the Head, CSE also for very obvious reasons (Dr. P.K.Patra-, Dr. B. Bhattacharjee – Annexure M and Prof M.S. Bisht – Annexure N)

XII. It is another matter that Prof. Singh did not recognize Dr. D. Bhattacharjee as the then legal Head of CSE during whose tenure Prof M.S. Bisht was appointed as a result of which Prof. Singh does not recognize Prof. M.S. Bisht also.

XIII. It may be mentioned that in respect of forwarding the leave applications, project proposals, letters addressed to the Head, CSE, Prof. M.M. Singh had acted in arbitrary and whimsical ways. In cases of Projects submitted by the faculty members of CSE to the University through him, as Head of CSE, Prof. Singh would say that he is not the Head of CSE and refused to forward the same. Immediately thereafter he would write to the University stating why he did not forward the Project. The latest such instance is the Project called “Skill

Development for livelihood earning based on local resources: scope and prospect of bamboo shoots for employment & income generation in North Eastern Region of India” submitted by Prof. M.S. Bisht of CSE which Prof. M.M. Singh initially refused to even receive but regarding which, he later on wrote formally as Head, CSE that he did not forward the same on the ground that it is not related to the work of CSE (Annexure O).

XIV. Letters addressed to him as Head, CSE are sometimes received and sometimes rejected by him according to his whim. The latest instance is the letter No.881 dated 14.6.2011(Annexure P) from Prof. T.B. Subba, Chairman, Editorial Board for Annual Report 2010-2011 requesting Prof. M.M. Singh to submit the full report of CSE for 2010-11 in the format enclosed therewith. Shri

R. Jana who had gone to deliver the letter reported vide his letter dated 14.6.2011 addressed to Prof. T.B. Suba, that Prof. M.M. Singh refused to receive the letter stating that he (Prof. M.M. Singh) is not the Head of CSE (Annexure Q).

XV. It is worth mentioning that Prof. Singh has time and again asked for release of some bills pertaining to CSE. The Finance Department has not released the same to him due to his failure to refund an amount of Rs.2,56,000.27 for which Finance Deptt. has written to him officially (Annexure R).

In the interest of the School of Science Education it may be considered whether his unilateral “relieving himself from the resumed duty of the acting Head of the Centre from 3.6.11 onwards” be treated as his letter of resignation and accordingly accepted.

Advice of the Legal Officer in view of the fact that the university has file the Appeal No. WA 15/2009 in the Principal Suit of the Guwahati High Court regarding appointment of Prof. M.M. Singh as Head of CSE is reproduced below:-

*“with a view to safeguard future administrative and legal complications Prof. Man Mohan Singh may be asked to submit a formal letter of resignation for consideration of the Competent Authority”*

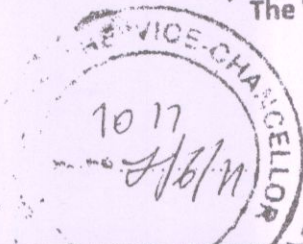

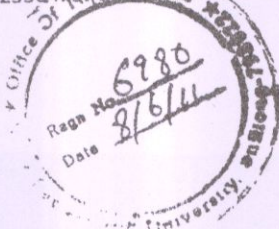

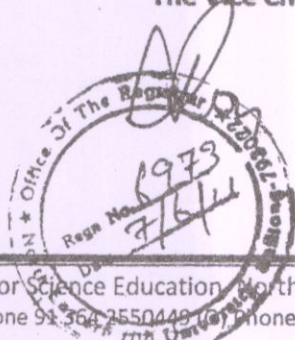

and (3) of the NEHU Statutes, and is not sustainable in law. This certainly warrants the interference of this Court.

13. The result of the foregoing discussion is that this writ petition is allowed. The impugned notification dated 8-11-2004 (Annexure-7), which might no longer be inoperative by efflux of time, is, nonetheless, hereby declared as illegal and was never operative. The respondent authorities shall now consider the case of the petitioner for re-appointment to the post of the Head of the Centre for Science Education in accordance with law and also keeping in mind the observations made by me in the foregoing paragraphs and take a decision thereon within a period of one month from the date of receipt of this judgment. Pending such decision and to avoid administrative or academic inconvenience or chaos in the Centre in the interregnum, the existing arrangement in the Centre shall continue. To remove any doubt, it is made clear that the current appointment of the respondent 6 as Head of the Centre for Science Education, whether as interim or otherwise, is subject to this judgment. The respondent authorities shall pay counsel's fees to the petitioner which is quantified at Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only).

(iv) Representation of Prof. M.M. Singh, Centre for Science Education – Pay fixation - regarding

Prof. M.M. Singh vide his letter dated 19<sup>th</sup> September, 2011 Annexure 'A' has written a letter to the Vice-Chancellor cum Chairman of the Executive Council to review his pay fixation consequent upon revision of pay scales of teachers from 1.1.06 in conformity with the Ministry of Human Resource Development Order dated 31.12.08 vis-à-vis Regulation 2010.

It may be noted that the revised pay of teachers including Professors were provisionally fixed with effect from 1.1.06 on the basis of fitment table provided by NEHUTA pending receipt of authenticated fitment table from MHRD. This was done with a view to release 40% of arrears to the employees of the University including teachers consequent upon revision of pay scales w.e.f. 1.1.06.

The pay of Prof. M.M. Singh w.e.f. 1.1.06 was provisionally fixed at the stage of Rs.51,850/- + 10,000/- academic grade pay. For reference Annexure 'B' may kindly be seen. Subsequently, the MHRD on 4<sup>th</sup> June, 2009 has forwarded the authenticated fitment table for fixation of pay of the existing incumbents (such as teachers and equivalent grades), who were in position as on 1.1.06. For reference Annexures 'C' and 'D' may kindly be seen. As per record, Prof. Singh was in receipt of basic pay of Rs.21,900/- as on 31.12.2006 and accordingly as per fitment table his pay was fixed at the stage of Rs.48,870/- with AGP of Rs.10,000/-.

The fitment table, as referred to above is also provided as Appendix to the UGC Regulation 2010. Thus, the pay fixed in respect of Prof. Singh is in order and there is no violation of MHRD order or UGC Regulation as stated by Prof. Singh.

Further, it may also be noted that as per Clause 6.8.0 (4.0) contained in the UGC Regulation 2010 provides that the pay of a direct recruited Professor shall be fixed at the stage not below Rs.43,000/- in the Pay Band – 4 i.e. Rs.37,400/- - Rs. 67,000/- with applicable AGP of Rs.10,000/-. For reference Annexures 'E' and 'F' may kindly be seen. Accordingly, the Professors who have been recruited directly on or after 1.1.06, their pay has been fixed at the minimum stage of Rs.43,000/- with AGP of Rs.10,000/-.

In view of the above, it is clear that the University is strictly following the UGC Regulation 2010 in the matter of pay fixation of teachers. It may be added that the pay fixation is not a decision of the University as the University has no discretion in the matter. Hence, the representation of Prof. M.M. Singh does not attract the provision of Section 32 of the NEHU Act.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.

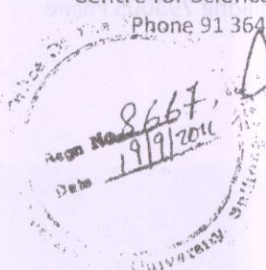

(FOR PAY SCALES, DESIGNATIONS AND STAGES OF PROMOTION UNDER CAS OF INCUMBENT AND NEWLY APPOINTED ASSISTANT PROFESSORS/ ASSOCIATE PROFESSORS/ PROFESSORS AND OTHER EQUIVALENT CADRES IN LIBRARY AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND SPORTS IN CENTRAL UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES THEREUNDER AND INSTITUTIONS DEEMED TO BE UNIVERSITIES WHOSE MAINTENANCE EXPENDITURE IS MET BY THE UGC).

- 1.0. Persons entering the teaching profession in universities and colleges shall be designated as Assistant Professors and shall be placed in the Pay Band III of Rs.15,600 – Rs. 39,100 with AGP of Rs. 6,000. Lecturers already in service in the pre-revised scale of Rs. 8,000 – Rs.13,500, shall be re-designated as Assistant Professors with the said AGP of Rs. 6,000. Their CAS promotions would be subject to the API criteria based PBAS system norms laid out in these regulations
- 1.1. An Assistant Professor with completed service of four years, possessing Ph. D. Degree in the relevant discipline shall be eligible, for moving to AGP of Rs.7,000.
- 1.2. An Assistant Professors possessing M.Phil. Degree or post-graduate degree in professional courses approved by the relevant statutory Body, such as LL.M. / M.Tech., etc. shall be eligible for the AGP of Rs. 7,000 after completion of five years service as Assistant Professor.
- 1.3. An Assistant Professors who do not have Ph.D. or M.Phil. or a Master degree in the relevant Professional course shall be eligible for the AGP of Rs. 7,000 only after completion of six years' service as Assistant Professor.
- 1.4. The upward movement from AGP of Rs. 6,000 to AGP of Rs. 7,000 for all Assistant Professors shall be subject to their satisfying the API criteria based PBAS conditions as laid down by the UGC in these Regulations.
- 2.0. The pay of the incumbents to the posts of Lecturer (senior scale) (i.e. the unrevised scale of Rs. 10,000 – Rs.15,200) shall be re-designated as Assistant Professor, and shall be fixed at the appropriate stage in Pay Band III of Rs.15,600 – Rs. 39,100 based on their present pay, with AGP of Rs. 7,000.
- 2.1. Assistant Professors with completed service of five years at the AGP of Rs. 7,000 shall be eligible, subject to other API requirements laid down by these UGC Regulations, to move up to the AGP of Rs. 8,000.
- 3.0. Posts of Associate Professor shall be in the Pay Band IV of Rs. 37,400 – Rs. 67,000, with AGP of Rs. 9,000. Directly recruited Associate Professors under these Regulations shall be placed in the Pay Band IV of Rs. 37,400 – Rs. 67,000 with an AGP of Rs. 9,000, at the appropriate stage in the Pay Band in terms of the conditions of appointment.
- 3.1. Incumbent Readers and Lecturers (Selection Grade) who have completed three years in the current pay scale of Rs. 12,000 – Rs. 18,300 on 1 January, 2006 shall be placed

in Pay Band IV of Rs. 37,400 – Rs. 67,000 with AGP of Rs. 9,000 and shall be re-designated as Associate Professor.

Incumbent Readers and Lecturers (Selection Grade) who had not completed three years in the pay scale of Rs.12,000 – Rs.18,300 on or after 1 January, 2006 shall be placed at the appropriate stage in the Pay Band of Rs.15,600 – Rs. 39,100 with AGP of Rs. 8,000 till they complete three years of service in the grade of Lecturer (Selection Grade) / Reader, and thereafter shall be placed in the higher Pay Band IV of Rs. 37,400 – Rs. 67,000 and accordingly re-designated as Associate Professor.

Readers/Lecturers (Selection Grade) in service at present shall continue to be designated as Lecturer (Selection Grade) or Readers, as the case may be, until they are placed in the Pay Band of Rs. 37,400 – Rs. 67,000 and re-designated as Associate Professor in the manner described in 3.1 and 3.2. above.

Assistant Professors completing three years of teaching in the AGP of Rs. 8,000 shall be eligible, subject to the qualifying conditions prescribed by these Regulations, to move to the Pay Band IV of Rs. 37,400 – Rs. 67,000 with AGP of Rs. 9,000 and to be designated as Associate Professor.

Associate Professor completing three years of service in the AGP of Rs. 9,000 and possessing a Ph.D. Degree in the relevant discipline shall be eligible to be appointed and designated as Professor, subject to satisfying the required credit points as per API based on PBAS methodology provided in Appendix IV, Table I-III stipulated in these Regulations and assessment by a duly constituted selection committee as suggested for the direct recruitment of Professor. No teacher other than those with a Ph.D. shall be promoted or appointed as Professor. The Pay Band IV for the post of Professors shall be Rs. 37,400 – Rs. 67,000 with AGP of Rs. 10,000.

4.0. The pay of a directly recruited Professor shall be fixed at a stage not below Rs.43,000 in the Pay Band IV of Rs. 37,400 – Rs. 67,000, with the applicable AGP of Rs.10,000.

4.1. Ten percent of the positions of Professors in a university shall be eligible to be placed in the higher AGP of Rs.12,000. However, teachers promoted to the posts with higher AGP of Rs.12,000, shall continue to be designated as Professor. Eligibility for elevation as a Professor in the higher Academic Grade Pay of Rs.12,000, shall be a minimum of ten years of teaching and research experience as professor either in the pre-revised scale of Professor's Pay of Rs.16,400 – Rs. 22,400 or the revised scale of Pay Band IV of Professor with AGP of Rs.10,000 on satisfying the required API score as per Tables I and II through the PBAS methodology stipulated in these Regulations through a duly constituted Expert committee;

## 5.0. PAY SCALES OF PRINCIPALS IN COLLEGES:

### 5.1 PRINCIPAL OF UNDER GRADUATE COLLEGES:

The posts of Principal in Under Graduate Colleges shall be in the Pay Band of Rs. 37,400 – Rs. 67,000 with AGP of Rs.10,000, plus a Special Allowance of Rs. 2,000 per month and shall also be fixed at a stage not below Rs. 43,000 as in the directly recruited


At the outset the Chairman Building Committee welcomed all the members present in the meeting.

**Item no BC: 104:1: Total Consultancy services for Guwahati Guest House.**

The Committee considered the request dated 13<sup>th</sup> September 2011 from the Architect M/S faws design and resolved that in the event of the completion cost of the building exceeding the detailed estimated amount by more than 10%, the firm shall be liable to be penalized to the 10% of his consultancy fee.

The schedule of the payment and time frame for submission of details shall be as under:

- a) 65% of the total fee shall be paid upon receipt of complete detailed drawings, estimates specification, bill of quantities etc and upon scrutiny, ensuring the correctness of the details so furnished.




- b) 25% of the total fee shall be paid on the completion of the work.
- c) 10% on submission of the as built drawings.
- d) The architect shall furnish complete details related to the project as per his scope of work with in a period of 45 (Forty five) days from the date of issue of fresh work order, failing which the work shall stand withdrawn.

The fee structure of the firm and extra payment towards soil testing, survey, site visits etc shall be in conformity with the recommendation of the Sub Committee dated 18.03.2011 and duly accepted by the 102<sup>nd</sup> Building Committee vide resolution no BC:102:13 held on dated 27<sup>th</sup> April 2011.

**Item no BC: 104:2 Payment of professional fee to M/S Space Ace for rendering consultancy services for Cluster of Class rooms and NEICOD.**

As resolved in the 102<sup>nd</sup> Building Committee held on 27<sup>th</sup> April 2011 vide resolution no BC:102:15, the CDD had prepared the statement showing fee payable to the architect for an amount of Rs.9,68,258.00 for NEICOD and Rs.29,16,193.00 for Cluster of Class rooms as per the terms of the respective agreements.

However the Committee was of the view that his fee should be worked out in proportion to the over all completion cost as per estimate recorded in the 102<sup>nd</sup> Building Committee meeting and Physical Progress. The Committee further authorized the Vice Chancellor to clear the same upon receipt of a detailed statement from CDD.





**Item no BC: 104:3 Consultancy services for the works to be taken up under the grant of Management Block at Tura Campus.**

The Committee noted that the architect M/S faws design were offered the works of architectural services for the Boy's Hostel, Girl's Hostel, Faculty staff quarters and Non teaching staff quarters on 4<sup>th</sup> May 2011.

The firm vide their letter dated 19<sup>th</sup> May 2011 have declined to accept the clause of compensation upto 50% on their total fee payable in the event of buildings can not be made functional with in the estimates approved by the University.

In view of the above facts the Committee resolved that the work allotted to the firm be withdrawn and process for selection of other architect be initiated by CDD, immediately.
