

**2. Proposal to construct a Memorial Stone of U Soso Tham.**

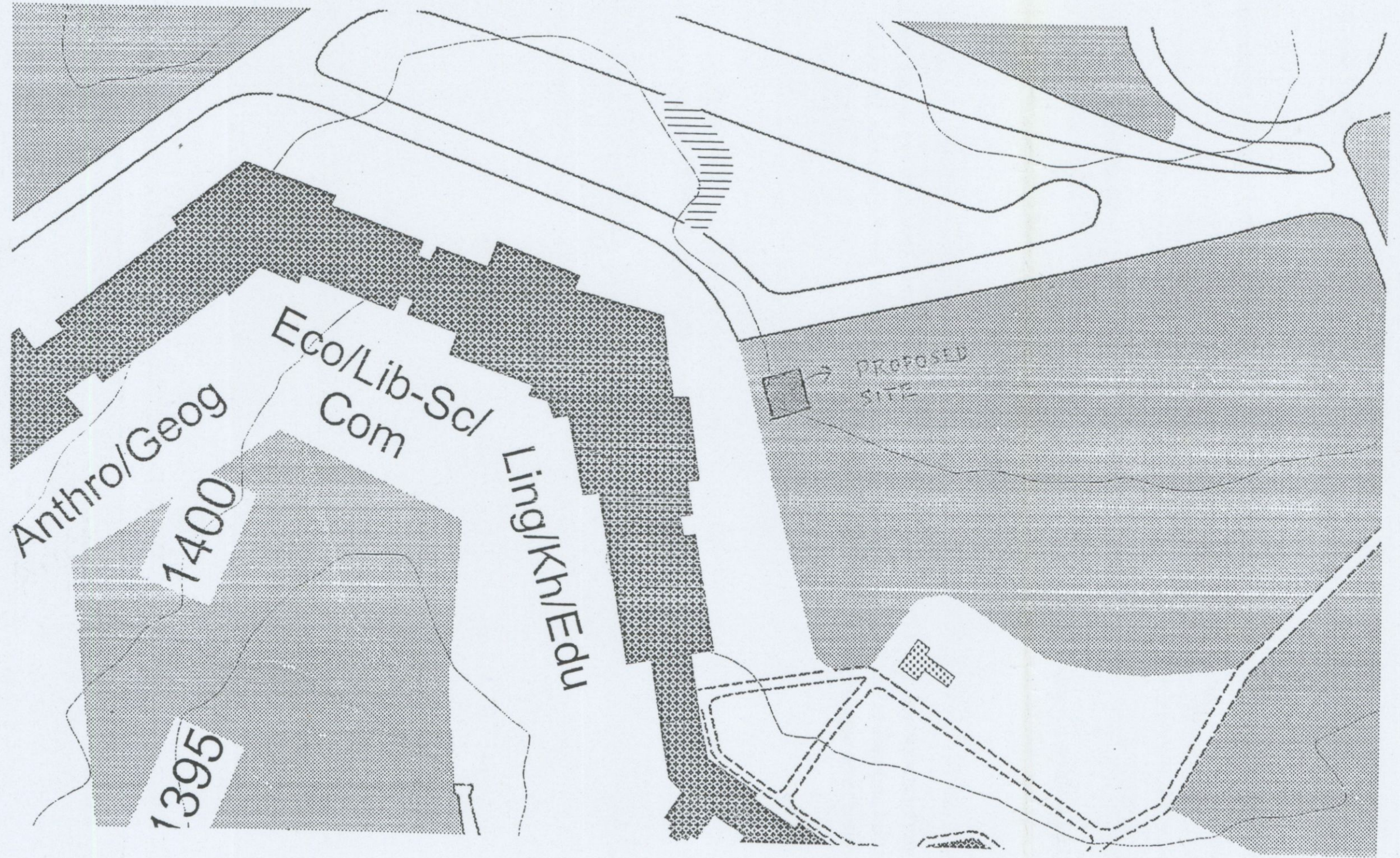

U Soso Tham's greatness does not lie in the number of poetry he wrote but in the thought content, the interpretation of which is unlimited. This being the case, it is felt that a person of such literary stature should be honoured by the Department of Khasi by placing his bust in a site selected by the Department. The Khasi Students' Union, Mawlai Unit has already agreed to donate the bust. The Unit has also submitted the draft plan for the same.

The Meeting after careful consideration, unanimously resolved to request the Vice-Chancellor to implement the proposal at the earliest convenient time.

There being no more agenda, the Meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the Chair.

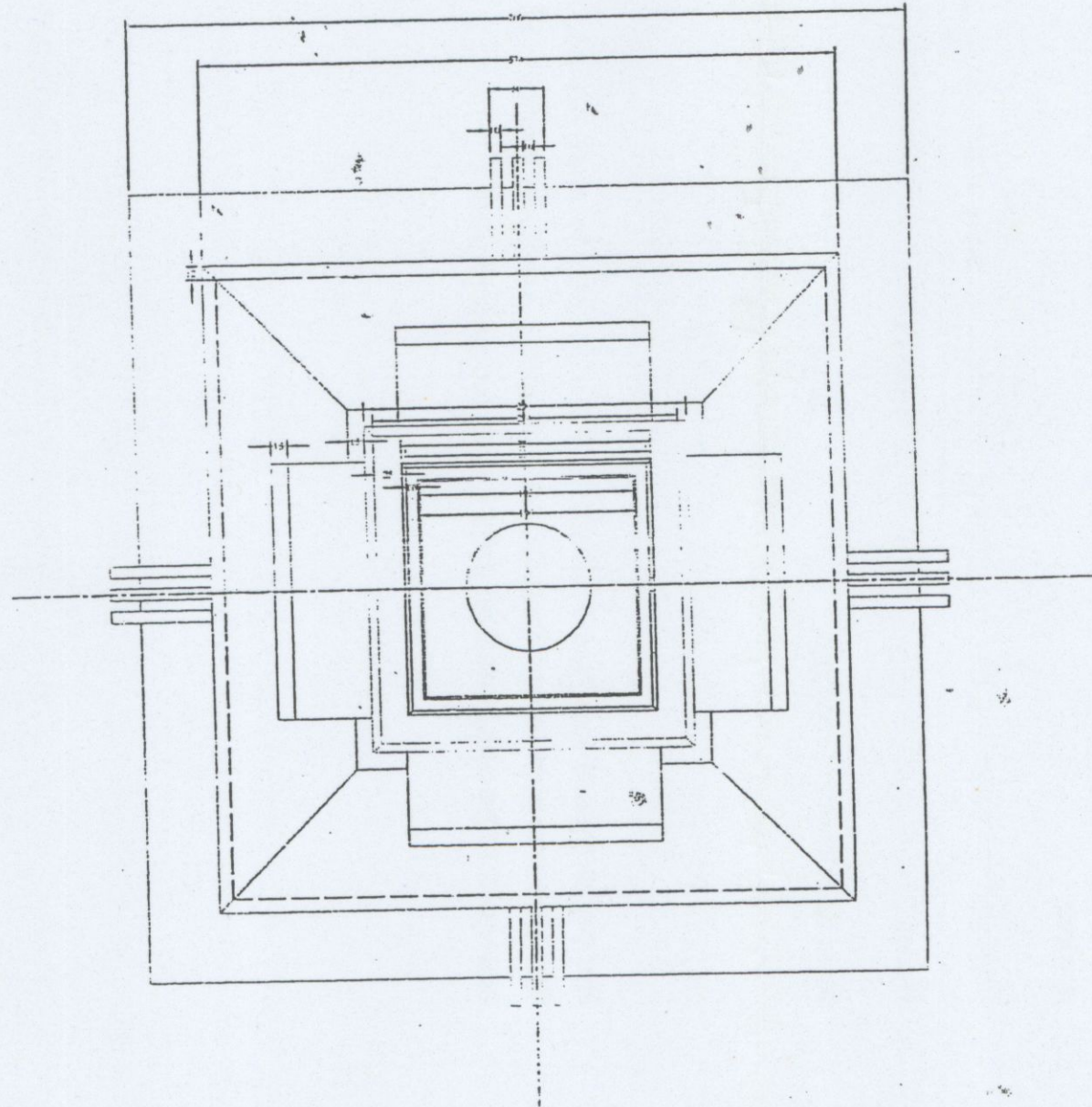
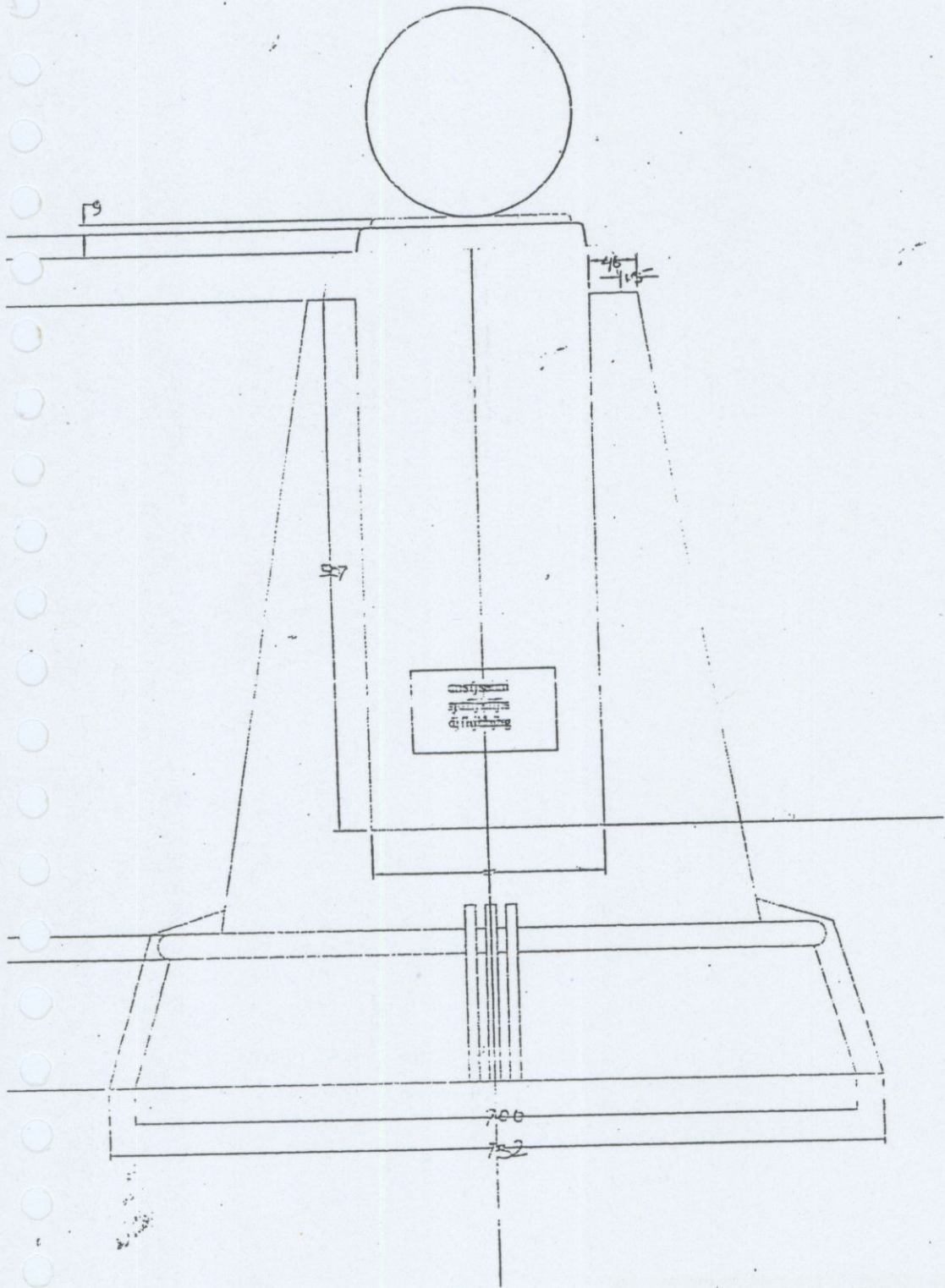

**(i) Request for permission to erect the monument of the great Khasi Poet, U Soso Tham.**

**EC:129:2007:5:8:(i):** The Council considered the request of the Head, Department of Khasi to erect a memorial stone in honour of the Khasi Poet, U Soso Tham and **RESOLVED** to approve the same.

**(ii) Enhancement of price of fee books.**

**EC:129:2007:5:8:(ii):** The Council considered the recommendation of the Academic Council taken in its 77<sup>th</sup> meeting in approving the enhancement of price of fee books and **RESOLVED** to approve the same as follows:

- (1) The fee book for professional course i.e. for B.Tech/M.Tech/Manegement/LLB is priced at Rs.61/- per book w.e.f. the first admission.
- (2) The fee book for the general course i.e. PG/Diploma/Certificate courses etc., is priced at Rs.10/- per book w.e.f. from the ensuing academic session commencing from June, 2007.

**(iii) Vice-Chancellor's assurances to the Hon'ble Committee of Parliament on Official Language for Oral Evidence on 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2006.**

**EC:129:2007:5:8:(iii):** The Council considered the recommendation of the Academic Council taken in its 77<sup>th</sup> meeting regarding the assurances made by the Vice-Chancellor to the Hon'ble Parliamentary Committee on Implementation of the Official Language and **RESOLVED** to accept that the provisions of the NEHU Act, Statutes and Ordinances be followed wherein the medium of teaching in the University and the affiliated colleges is English, and as such, arrangements for imparting education in Hindi would not be feasible. The Council, however, noted that while written examinations have to be held in English candidates appearing for interviews may be allowed to reply in Hindi.

**(iv) Change of nomenclature.**

**EC:129:2007:5:8:(iv):** The Council considered the recommendation of the Academic Council taken in its 77<sup>th</sup> meeting in approving the change of nomenclature of the Jowai Campus to "College of Applied Sciences" and **RESOLVED** to approve the same.
