Sir,

May I bring to your notice that there exist some ambiguity in the Regulation RB -2 No. 2, the clause which reads as "Provided that in Special cases of outstanding merit and administrative ability, the length of experience may be relaxed upto five years." It is not known how to determine **outstanding merit and or administrative ability**, whether the University has adopted any modalities or mechanism how to satisfy the above requirement or not. Perhaps it would be better to discuss the point in the forth coming Academic Council so as to avoid any arbitrary decisions on such an important issue.

## NORTH EASTERN HILL UNIVERSITY

RB-2

**ON MINIMUM STAFFING REQUIREMENT**  
(Under Ordinance OB -6)

1. Subject to the provision as laid down in the Regulations concerning the duties of the teachers and minimum number of classes per week, the minimum staffing requirement of a college shall be as prescribed below.
  - (i) No College shall be granted affiliation if it fails to satisfy such minimum requirement.
  - (ii) Three year Degree Course, Science (General). At least four teachers for each subject.
  - (iii) Three year Degree Course, Science (Honours). At least five teachers for each subject.
  - (iv) Three year Degree Course (per programme) Arts/ Commerce (General). At least three teachers for each subject.
  - (v) Three year degree course, (per programmes). (Honours) Arts/ Commerce/ for each subject....

Note: However in a college where English is taught only as a compulsory subject there shall be at least four teachers. But in a college where English /MIL is also taught as Honours subject there shall be at least five teachers in each subject.

**Qualification 2.  
of Teaching  
staff**

**Principal:** A principal of a college shall be a whole time officer, preferably with administrative experience. The age of retirement and qualifications for the post will be as per UGC norms.

Provided in special cases of outstanding merit and or administrative ability, the length of experience may be relaxed upto five years. His minimum age will be 35 years and will not exceed in any case beyond 62 years.

3. **Lecturer:** As per UGC norms.

- (v) Application form for Renewal and Permanent affiliation of P.G. Courses in Colleges.

The Ordinance on P.G. Departments in College affiliated to the University has become operative . Under this Ordinance, the application form for permission to start P.G. Departments in an existing College has been approved. St. Anthony's College, Shillong which has started P.G. courses in M.C.A and M.Sc-Biotech has requested the form for permanent affiliation for these courses. The affiliation Committee meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> August 2007 requested Prof. K.Ismail to draft the application form for Renewal and Permanent affiliation of P.G. courses in Colleges, which is being sent by e-mail.

The draft form is appended for consideration and approval of Council.

**5:1:6(1)**

(vi) Regulation on Permanent Affiliation for P.G. Courses.

The University has permitted P.G. Courses in College. St. Anthony's College has P.G.Courses in M.C.A and M.Sc-Bio-Tech. In course of time this College and other Colleges which will apply for P.G. courses will seek permanent affiliation of P.G. programmes. The Academic Council may discuss the matter and consider a regulation for Permanent affiliation of P.G. Courses in College.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.
