

- (1) Regulation for attending Seminar/Conference in regards of single author and suggestion to the Deans' Committee for perusal and decision thereof.

On the regulation for attending Seminar/Conference in regards of single author, the Academic Council which was held on 10 & 20 Nov., 1998 and the item was withdrawn by the Chairman and the Council authorised the Chairman to taken action on receipt of clarification from the UGC. However since the Regulation was framed by NEHU bodies, clarification has not been sought from UGC and the matter was placed back before the 87th meeting of the Deans' Committee held on 11.3.1999. The Committee vide item NO.6 of the minutes has resolved as follows and suggested to place the matter before the Academic Council for its perusal and final decision; there the extract is reproduced as below :

"In consideration to the above subject matter the Committee RESOLVED to suggest that the regulation on the single authorship papers which determines the eligibility criteria for attending National Conference as per Clause(iv) of the said regulation may now be modified as below :-

- (iv) "The members of faculty proposing to participate may intimate will in advance alongwith the title of the paper which he/she wants to present. These teachers who have to their credit, published works (single/multiple authors) in the preceding two years are eligible to apply".

Further in the prescribed format/application (enclosed) for attending conference, some addition is to be made on clause (b) with a star Mark (*), in the same prescribed format to be printed fresh as indicated below :-

- *" In case of multiple author paper(s), the intending participant shall submit a letter of undertaking from all other co-author that the letter have/will not claimed/claim financial assistance from the University for the purpose, under the same published paper".

The above suggestions was placed to the Academic Council for its perusal and decision."

The matter was placed before the 60th meeting of the Academic Council and the Council Resolved that in case of multiple authors paper(s) presenting author will be eligible of financial assistance if he fulfil the criteria

The matter is placed fore the Council for consideration.
