The Academic Council in its 84th meeting held on 15th November, 2010 vide resolution NO:AC:84:2010:5:5:(xiv) considered the request for assignment of new Ph.D. Supervisor and change of subject research and after deliberation on the matter the Council **RESOLVED** that *change of topic and Supervisor is not allowed under the old Ordinance OC-4 (4) (ii)*, but modified title only is allowed. The Council therefore **RESOLVED** that if the students wish to change the topic a new Supervisor be appointed by the Department of Physics and the students should re-register under the new regulation where Course work is mandatory.
