

(vii) Case of Shri S.L.Marbaniang,
Lecturer, Deptt. of Mathematics.

The Executive Council vide resolution No:EC: 108:2000:6:2:(x) held on 8.12.2000, RESOLVED that Shri S.L. Marbaniang be allowed to rejoin the Department of Mathematics consequent upon the repealment of Cl.3(iii) of Regulation RE-6 and further RESOLVED that regularisation of the period from the date of his voluntary retirement and date of rejoining may be examined and placed before the Council.

In this connection Cl.3(iii) of Regulation RE-6 having been repealed, Shri S.L.Marbaniang has been allowed to join the post earlier held by him prior to his voluntary retirement with effect from 15.2.2000 with pay @ Rs.11,575/- (Provisional) last drawn on his proceeding on voluntary retirement on 19.1.98 pending further examination of the interim period. The amendment to Cl.3(iii) of Regulation RE-6 has been superseded and the position as it stood prior to the amendment has been restored with retrospective effect vide 108th Executive Council and notification dt.21.8.2000.

Hence, the interim period may be regularised by granting him Extra-Ordinary leave giving him all service benefits including notional increment on his joining the post, and keeping the seniority as well. However, this being a special case, may not fall under Cl.8(iii)(d) of OE-6 of Ordinance governing leave to teachers and the Pension Contribution liable for payment by Shri Marbaniang may not arise.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.
