

6: 6 - Service Condition/Financial & Other Benefits--

- (i) IMPLEMENTATION OF PLACEMENT OF SHRI.N.A.HUNTHANBOU,
DARK ROOM CAMERA OPERATOR IN THE APPROVED PAY SCALE
OF Rs.1400-40-1800-EB-50-2300/-.

The posts of Dark room camera operator and that of Plate-maker were advertised in the year 1991 vide No.Advt/F-2/91-6784 dated 30.11.91 in the scale of pay of Rs.1400-40-1800-EB-50-2300/- each. Shri.Hunthanbou was one of the applicants who fulfilled the eligibility criteria laid down for the post of Dark room camera operator. However, on the proposal of the former Director of Publication (Shri.J.B.Bhattacharjee) it was decided that only one post be filled in with a lower scale of pay of Rs.1200-30-1560-EB-40-2040/- combining the duties of both posts, as the work load in the department was then not so much and one person was enough to perform the duties of the above two mentioned posts.

Candidates who consented to this arrangement were interviewed and Shri.Hunthanbou was one of them. He was selected for appointment as Dark room camera operator in the lower scale of pay of Rs.1200-2040/- w.e.f. 26.2.93 and has been performing the duties of the said two posts. Subsequently with the implementation of the 10% cut policy, the post of Plate-maker was placed under cut.

Shri.Hunthanbou represented for granting the higher pay scale of Rs.1400-2300/- as per advertisement as this is the pay scale of Cameraman of Central Government service and also the approved pay scale for the post of Dark room camera operator in this University. The present Director also recommended him for the same.

In view of the recommendation of the Director, Publication Cell and on finding that Shri.Hunthanbou fulfilled the required qualification and experience for the post, the proposal for placement of Shri.Hunthanbou in the Higher scale of pay of Rs.1400-2300/- was placed before the Selection Committee meeting dated 15.7.96. The Committee recommended that the incumbent be allowed the scale of pay of Rs.1400-2300/- as advertised, from the date of his appointment on regular basis as Dark room camera operator i.e. w.e.f. 26.2.93. The minutes of the same has also been duly approved by the Vice-Chancellor on 20.7.96.

However, before implementation of the same, the Vice-Chancellor desires that the matter be referred to the E.C. for its consideration and approval.
