

(ii) Starting of the Department of M C A

The School Board in Economics, Management & Information Sciences in its meeting held on the 28.10.98 resolved that the placement of the Department of Computer Applications in a School should be made on the basis of interaction and need and also in the light of the origin of proposal for opening the said Department. Computer Application is a part of information Sciences and will be heavily required by Departments like Economics, Library & Information Science, Management and Commerce. So it would be justified that the Department be placed in the School of Economics, Management & Information Science. There may be a justification of placing of Department of Computer Science in the School of Physical Sciences, but the Department of Computer Applications, right placement would be in the School of Economics, Management & Information Sciences. The matter was placed in the 58th meeting of the Academic Council held on 10th September, 1998 wherein, the Council vide Resolution No:AC:58:95:5:6(ii) resolved to place the Department of Computer Applications in the School of Physical Sciences and the Executive Council in its 98th meeting vide Resolution No:98:98:5:6(i) consider the proposal and resolved that it be named as the Department of Computer Applications and further resolved to refer back the matter to the Academic Council with a proper write-up on its background for placement in the proper School.

The matter was placed before the 59th meeting of the Academic Council which RESOLVED that the Department of Computer Applications be placed under the School of Economics, Management and Information Sciences.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.

5:7- AFFILIATION ETC.

(i) Inspection Reports of various Colleges for Permanent / Renewal / Initial affiliation.

EC:99:98:5:7: (i): The Council considered the recommendations of the Academic Council on the permanent / renewal / initial affiliation of the following Colleges and while approving the affiliations subject to fulfilment of the conditions laid down by the Inspection Teams RESOLVED that all the Colleges under the jurisdiction of the University be required to make appointments of their teachers as per the UGC norms including NET examinations.

As regards NERIST a Show Cause Notice be issued as to why the privileges of NEHU should not be withdrawn on the following grounds:

- (a) Collecting fees in the name of NEHU without obtaining any prior authority or permission from the University.
- (b) Using the seal and designation of the Vice - Chancellor of NEHU in the fee receipts without any authority or permission from the University.

The Chairman is authorised to take necessary action on the reply from NERIST which should be submitted latest by 10.1.1999.
